Access to Food Assistance Options in Berrien County

Michigan Bridge Card: Through MI Bridges, apply for assistance with the Michigan Bridge Card, which is ***Michigan's Electronic Benefits Card*** that looks and works like a debit or credit card but is loaded with food stamps (also known as SNAP benefits) and/or cash benefits. Use it at stores that accept EBT. To register, go to <https://newmibridges.michigan.gov>.

Benton Harbor Soup Kitchen: 11:30am -12:50pm daily; 233 Michigan at the back of Salvation Army.

Feel Good Fridge: Fridges that are stocked with healthy snacks and beverages in a variety of locations across the area. Available at: Harbor of Hope; Harbor House; Michigan Works; Mosaic; St. Augustine Episcopal Church; Caring Cupboard at Woodland Shores.

Mobile Pantry Services: Check feedwm.org/mobile-pantry-schedule for current information or find the location of the pantry and call first. Mobile pantries listed here are drive-thru for pre-packed boxes and most are monthly. Available at: Kinexus/Benton Harbor; Benevolent Ministries/Benton Harbor; Woodland Shores Baptist Church/Bridgman; Stevensville United Methodist/Stevensville; Harbert Community Church/Sawyer; New Buffalo American Legion/New Buffalo; Episcopal Church of the Mediator/New Troy; Neighbor to Neighbor/Berrien Springs.

Food Assistance Boxes: Oakridge Community Church; open the second and third Tuesday, 1-3pm and Thursday, 6-7pm, 766 Oakridge Drive, St. Joseph.

Food Pantries: *Road to Hope* happens on the third Saturday of the month from 12-2pm and the first Tuesday from 6:30-8pm in the Road to Hope building behind Road to Life Church, 3800 Niles Road in St. Joseph. Our Lady Queen of Peace weekly on Tuesday from 10am-12pm and Thursday between 6-7:30pm, 3903 Lake Street, Bridgman.
