The current inside working agreement requires in Section 3.19 (d) that "All Foreman shall be required to complete a mutually agreed upon Foremanship course in order to act in a supervisor capacity". The Foreman is the critical link between upper management and the workers who actually install the work on the job site. No one has more impact on the outcome of the job than the Foreman.
