How to Get Started

2. **Complete a Background Check:**

To ensure a safe environment for our athletes, all volunteers must complete a standard background screening through Georgia Soccer. You will receive a secure link via email once you've registered on the portal.

3. **Safety Training:**

Complete the brief, online **SafeSport** and **Heads Up Concussion** training. These certifications ensure you are equipped to protect the physical and emotional well-being of the players.

4. **Attend the Coaches' Clinic:**

Before the season kicks off at Clifftondale Park, join us for a quick orientation. We'll provide you with a "Coach's Starter Kit," including practice plans, equipment, and a review of the age-specific rules.
