
- 1. At what address is the burn going to take place? Also, where on the property will it be occurring?

- 3. Burning must be conducted downwind of or at least 300 feet from any structure containing sensitive receptors, unless prior written approval is obtained from the adjacent occupant with possessory control.

Identify any schools, churches, daycares, or homes within 300 feet of your burn.

- The County has designated hours of operation for all burns to be from 8 A.M. to 4 P.M. Burning shall not commence when surface wind speed is predicted less than 6 mph or greater than 23 mph. Please tell us the time you will begin burning and when you will end burning.
