

Baptism of Infants - Please contact the office and register as far in advance as possible for baptism preparation class. Every parent and godparent must attend this session before a baptism may be scheduled.

Reconciliation (Confession) - Fridays 11:00 am—11:50 AM and Saturday 3 pm - 4 pm or anytime requested

First Communion - Students from second grade on receiving Sacramental Preparation with 1 yr. prior instruction in the Catholic Faith are eligible.

Confirmation - Students in ninth grade receiving Sacramental Preparation with previous instruction in the Catholic Faith are eligible.

Anointing of the Sick - For a pastoral visit (at home, nursing home, hospital) or the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, please contact the office.

Marriage - Schedule a meeting with the Pastor for instructions, forms, etc. Preparation prior to marriage requires a minimum of six months.

Blood Drive


