The pool and guards are professionally managed by Winkler Pool Service.

Annual community dues MUST be paid prior to your family being admitted to use the pool. Assessments were due May 1st.

All questions or concerns may be directed to BOD@Chartridge.com. Tenants within Chartridge should confirm with the homeowner that they have access to the pool.

If we do not have record of your payment we cannot allow entry to the pool.

Please review the below pool rules and regulations and see new instructions for accessing the pool below.

Chartridge Community Pool: Rules & Regulations

Purpose: These rules and regulations, along with those mandated by the Anne Arundel County Health Department, are established for the safety, health, and enjoyment of all members and guests using the Chartridge Community Pool facilities. Compliance ensures a safe, sanitary, and pleasant environment for everyone. Your adherence to these rules is mandatory for accessing and using the pool facilities.

Enforcement: All members, guests, and staff are expected to follow these rules. Chartridge Board of Directors members, Pool Committee members, and Pool Staff are authorized to enforce these regulations.

- Failure to comply may result in immediate removal from the pool facilities.
- Violation of these rules can lead to suspension or termination of pool privileges as outlined in the Chartridge Community Declaration of Covenants, Conditions & Restrictions (Article II Section 1, b.).
- Eviction from the facilities will result in an automatic minimum 24-hour suspension.
- Pool Management reserves the right to contact the Anne Arundel County Police Department if necessary.
- Repeat offenders will be referred to the Pool Committee for potential further suspension. Guardians of offenders under 18 will be required to sign a notification form.
- Any act of vandalism to the pool or common areas will subject the individual(s) to suspension by the Chartridge Board of Directors and potential police involvement.

I. Age & Supervision Requirements

1. **Unaccompanied Access:** Children must be at least **12 years old** AND have passed the Basic Swim Test to enter the pool area without adult supervision.
2. **Non-Swimmers:** A non-swimmer is defined as anyone under the age of 16 who cannot pass the Basic Swim Test.
 - Non-swimmers of any age may not visit the pool without adult supervision.
 - Guardians must remain actively engaged and within arm's reach of non-swimmers aged 10 and under at all times while they are in the water.

- Non-swimmers (ages 12-15) may enter the main pool to a depth up to their shoulders without direct arm's-reach supervision, but must still be adequately supervised by a responsible adult within the pool facility.
 - Any non-swimmer deemed inadequately supervised will be asked to exit the water.
3. **Babysitting:** Individuals must be 15 years of age or older to supervise children (act as a babysitter) at the pool facility.

II. Basic Swim Test & Identification

1. **Test Requirements:** To pass the Basic Swim Test, an individual must:
 - Swim one full length of the main pool without stopping.
 - Tread water for one (1) minute in the deep end of the main pool.
2. **Wristbands:**
 - Lifeguards will administer the test and provide approved wristbands to members and guests who pass.
 - Wristbands must be worn during every pool visit to identify swimmers.
 - Individuals who forget their wristband must retake the swim test to receive a temporary band for the day or a replacement band.
 - Sharing or transferring wristbands is prohibited. Swimmers found sharing bands will be required to exit the water.

III. Wading Pool (Baby Pool) Rules

- **Primary Use:** The wading pool is intended primarily for children 6 and under who have not passed the Basic Swim Test.
- **Supervision:** Constant adult supervision is mandatory. **NO LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY** specifically for the wading pool area.
- **Swim Diapers:** In accordance with Health Department regulations, all non-toilet-trained children **MUST** wear approved swim diapers. Regular disposable diapers are strictly prohibited.
- **Hygiene:** A changing table is available in the women's restroom. Report any vomit or fecal contamination to the lifeguards immediately.
- **Consideration:** During busy periods and adult swim times in the main pool, older children capable of swimming in the main pool are asked to refrain from overcrowding the wading pool to allow space for younger children. The area is specifically for children 6 and under.
- **Equipment:** Do not place chairs or other furniture inside the wading pool. Please return all wading pool toys to their designated storage area before leaving.

IV. General Pool Regulations & Conduct

1. **Permitted Activities & Items:**
 - Showering before entering the pool is required. Volleyball players must rinse off all sand before pool entry.
 - Wheelchairs and strollers are permitted on the deck.
 - Swimming goggles and diving masks are allowed.
 - Diving is permitted **ONLY** in the designated deep well area. No running dives.
 - Pool noodles, water wings (arm floaties), and kickboards are generally allowed (subject to lifeguard discretion during crowded conditions).
2. **Prohibited Activities & Items:**
 - **Running** on the pool deck is strictly forbidden.

- **Glass containers** of any kind are prohibited within the pool enclosure.
- **Smoking and vaping** are not permitted within the pool enclosure.
- **Abusive behavior, foul language, or disruptive conduct** will not be tolerated.
- **Diapers** (other than approved swim diapers in the wading pool) are not allowed in the main pool. Non-toilet-trained children are not permitted in the main pool.
- **Water guns** of any type are prohibited.
- **Inner tubes, large rafts, and swim fins** are not allowed (except during officially designated "raft night" events).
- **Spitting, blowing nose, or urinating** in the pool is prohibited.
- **Animals** (except for certified service animals) are not allowed.
- **Band-aids** are not permitted in the water.
- **Ball playing** on the pool deck is prohibited.
- **Rollerblades, bicycles, skateboards, scooters, etc.,** are not permitted inside the pool enclosure.

V. Guest Policy

1. **Definition:** A guest is any person who does not reside within the Chartridge community boundaries. This includes non-resident babysitters/nannies and adult children who no longer live in the member's Chartridge home. Relatives and grandchildren visiting members are considered guests.
2. **Accompaniment & Sign-In:** All guests must be signed in upon entry and accompanied by their sponsoring Chartridge resident member at all times while using the facilities.
3. **Guest Fees:** A \$3.00 per guest fee applies for daily pool use. Passes must be purchased through the membersplash account via credit card. See instructions further in this packet.
4. **Member Responsibility:** Members are fully responsible for the conduct and safety of their guests and ensuring their guests adhere to all pool rules.
5. **Signing in Guests (Minors):** Members under the age of 15 may not sign in a guest unless that guest is 11 years of age or older AND is able to pass the Basic Swim Test.
6. **Non-Resident Nanny/Babysitter:** Must be at least 15 years old. The employing member must provide a signed guest pass authorizing the nanny/babysitter to bring the member's children to the pool.
7. **Parties:** Bringing more than 10 guests at one time constitutes a pool party and requires prior approval from the Pool Committee, submission of a party rental form, and potentially arranging for extra lifeguard coverage. Forms are available at www.Chartridge.com/forms.

VI. Ultimate Responsibility

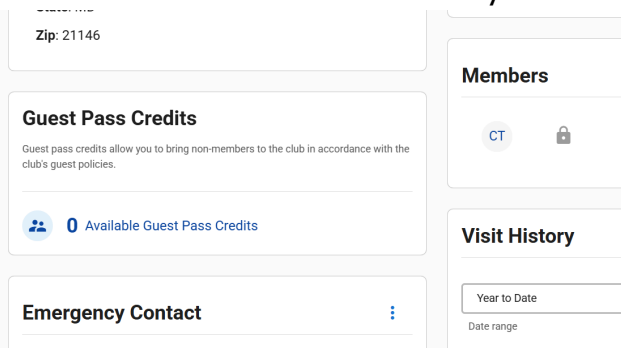
While lifeguards are on duty for the safety of all patrons in the main pool, **the parent or guardian is always ultimately responsible for the safety and supervision of their children.**

Pool Access Info - Account Set Up - New since 2025

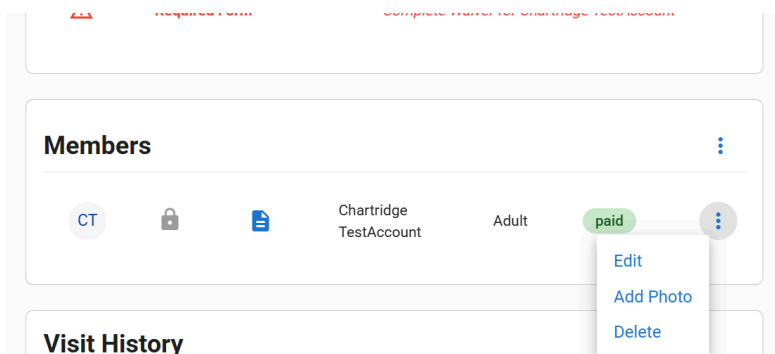
To access the pool facility, residents must be registered in the new registration system hosted by Member Splash.

- Access your Chartridge Pool Account at <https://chartridge.membersplash.com/>
 - Use the email with which you received your annual assessment notice.
 - Your initial password will be **chartridgeHOA**, change it immediately.
 - If you do not receive emails for your assessment, you can request a new account here <https://chartridge.membersplash.com/membership/join/>
 - Once your account is approved you can proceed to the steps below.
 - Only one account per household is permitted
- Upon accessing your account, you will see 4 tasks that you must complete
 - Add an Emergency Contact
 - Add a Photo
 - Update your birthdate
 - Complete the Waiver where you will acknowledge the members of your household are full time residents and agree to the rules and regulations

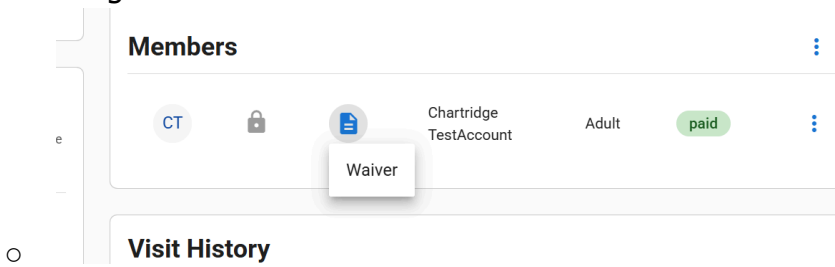
- Emergency Contact

Pool Guest Information - New since 2025

Anyone who is not a full time Chartridge resident must utilize a guest pass to gain access to the pool facility. Guest passes can be purchased through a residents Member Splash account.

Steps to purchase guest passes:

1. To purchase, got to <https://chartridge.membersplash.com/>
2. From the menu at the top left, select the "Payments" tab the select "Make a Payment"
3. You will see options to purchase single passess or multiple passses. Complete the payment process and you will see the guest passess appear on you Member Splash account

Pool Check-In Information - New since 2025

All residents and guests must check-in at the front desk prior to using the facility for the day.

If you are bringing a guest, you must check-in and register your guest with the lifeguards and the front desk.
