

Second Grade Supply List

- Backpack
- Pencil Box or Pouch – A durable case to store pencils, erasers, and other small items.
- No. 2 Pencils – At least two dozen pre-sharpened pencils. Many teachers prefer Ticonderoga or similar brands for durability.
- Crayons – Two boxes of 24-count crayons (Crayola is recommended)
- Washable Markers – A set of 10 classic colors thick or thin. (Crayola is recommended)
- Glue Sticks – At least four large glue sticks.
- Child-Safe Scissors – Blunt-tip scissors sized for young children.
- Folders – 3 two-pocket and 3 brad folders plastic. 1 blue, 1 red and 1 students' choice of color.
- Composition Notebook – Two sturdy composition notebooks
- Highlighters – Two assorted color highlighters for important notes and activities.
- Dry Erase Markers – Four low-odor dry erase markers for whiteboard work.

Personal and Organizational Items

- Water Bottle – A reusable, spill-proof water bottle labeled with your child's name
- Headphones – For computer learning and listening centers (often with a 3.5mm jack). Please no ear buds.
- Tissues – 4 Pack of tissues to contribute to the class supply.
- Hand Sanitizer – 1 bottle to contribute the class supply
- Disinfecting Wipes – To help teachers keep desks and supplies clean.

Art Supplies

- Construction Paper – An assorted pack for crafts and creative assignments.

- Label all supplies with your child's name to prevent loss and confusion.
- Encourage your child to help organize their supplies before the first day—it builds excitement and responsibility.
