Volunteers at Stepping Stone Ministries provide compassionate support to individuals experiencing homelessness as they recover from injury or illness. Our volunteers are dedicated to fostering dignity, respect, and hope through service, as we create an environment of supportive healing for our residents.

Description

Laundry and cleaning are big chores in our ministry, and we would love to have some help with it. Our facility care volunteers come and use our in-house laundry machines to help wash bedding, towels and clothes. They will also help us clean rooms between residents, keep our communal spaces clean, and ensure that everyone who comes through our facility has a clean safe space to heal.

Requirements

- 18 years old or older
- willing to come in at least monthly, for 3 months
- Knows how to do laundry
- can clean rooms, vacuum, sweep, mop, and wash.

Time Commitment

Picking a day and time can be flexible, but we ask that our facility care volunteers come long enough to do at least 3 loads of laundry. While laundry is going you will help us keep our space clean by doing some household cleaning. You are also encouraged to meet with residents and help foster our communal life.

Impact

Facility Care Volunteers ensure each of our guests have a nice clean space to live in. They ensure all new residents feel great in a clean room and that all our current residents have clean bedding each week.
