Volunteers at Stepping Stone Ministries provide compassionate support to individuals experiencing homelessness as they recover from injury or illness. Our volunteers are dedicated to fostering dignity, respect, and hope through service, as we create an environment of supportive healing for our residents.

Description

The Hope and Hospitality Volunteer's role is to facilitate communal life in our home. While at SSM you work directly with our residents serving their very basic needs. This volunteer will do the little things that bring basic comfort and hope to our residents on their journey towards healing. You will make, serve, and clean up lunch or dinner, engage in conversation and activities with residents, and help do some basic cleaning of our communal spaces.

Requirements

- 18 years old or older
- Willing to make a commitment of at least bi-monthly for 3 months
- Willing to be attentive to both emotional and physical needs of residents
 - o Ex, serving lunch, being a liaison for the kitchen, having conversations
- Willing to facilitate communal life through activities.
 - o Ex, movies, games, meals
- Willing to do light household chores
 - o Ex, wiping down table, cleaning up kitchen after meals, light laundry

Time Commitment

This position is needed on any day during the week. We ask for the volunteer to come mid-morning through lunch for that transitional time. We will work out specific hours with you.

Impact

The Hope and hospitality volunteer position makes a huge difference not just for our residents but for our staff. We are a small team and having an extra hand in the office to do some little things helps us get our work done so we can grow to serve even more residents.
