



Volunteer Driver

Volunteers at Stepping Stone Ministries provide compassionate support to individuals experiencing homelessness as they recover from injury or illness. Our volunteers are dedicated to fostering dignity, respect, and hope through service, as we create an environment of supportive healing for our residents.

Description

The Volunteer Driver is an essential part of the recovery of our residents. The role of a volunteer driver is to help drive clients to and from appointments or other locations, ensuring our residents get the support they need. Drivers will not be using their own cars but will be driving our ministry vehicles.

Requirements

- 18 years old or older
- Must have a valid driver's license and clean driving record
- Must pass a background check
- Willing to commit time at least weekly for 3 months
- Must have a cellphone with maps or good navigation skills.

Time Commitment

Drivers are needed Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 and 4. Because every week will look different, we will work directly with you to make your schedule. You will pick a day or days you are generally available, and we will match that with our appointment needs.

Impact

Our drivers have a huge impact on our residents and staff. For our residents it ensures their ability to attend the appointments they need to heal. One of the most common reasons people experiencing homelessness do not heal from their injury or illness is because they can't get to their follow-up appointments, the volunteer driver eliminates that problem.
