

# Minutes of St. Peter's Vestry

May 18, 2026

**Attendance:** Mother Sarah, Tom Priddy, Todd LaFrance, Ken Shabel, Gayle McKee, Nick Morse, Tim Wilkerson, Gina Pelino, Frank Boineau, Lindsay Hawkins, Harrison Hitner.

Mother Sarah called the meeting to order with prayer at 6pm.

**Approval of Minutes:** Tim Wilkerson motioned Vestry to accept the minutes of April 20, 2026. Gina Pelino seconded, and the minutes were accepted.

## **Treasurer's Report for the month ending April, 2026:**

### **Income**

Pledge payments for April were \$26.6k, which was \$10.5k under the budget of \$37.1k. Total revenues for April were \$35.4k, which was 11.0k, under the budget of \$46.4k, due to increased non-pledge payments.

### **Expense**

Total expenses for April were \$47.0k as compared to the budget of \$50.9k.

### **Net Operating Result**

Monthly expenses were less than the budget. However, the significantly lower total revenues in April resulted in a loss of \$11.6k. Year-to-date, there was a net favorable surplus of \$44.4k versus a net budgeted surplus of \$48.9k, yielding an unfavorable change of \$4.5k.

Tim Wilkerson motioned to approve the Treasurer's Report for the month ending April 2026. Todd LaFrance seconded, and the motion was approved.

The Vestry voted to elect Lindsay Hawkins to the Vestry to fill a vacancy.

Harrison Hitner will work on St. Peter's search for a part time youth minister for SPY.

Gayle McKee reported that St. Peter's donated 46 packages for the women at Safe Harbor.

Tim Wilkerson motioned to call a special session of the Vestry on May 26, 2026, at 6:00pm. Nick Morse seconded, and the motion carried.

Tom Priddy closed the meeting with prayer.

Tim Wilkerson motioned to adjourn the meeting. Ken Shabel seconded, and the motion carried.

Our next meeting will be on Monday June 15, 2026, at 6pm.
