The Pandora Village Council met in Regular Session on Tuesday, March 10, 2026, at 7:00 PM at the Municipal Building, with Mayor, Jeremy Liechty, presiding.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion was made by Mr. Fricke, seconded by Mrs. Lammers, to approve the February 24, 2026 Minutes. Voting: All Yea.

Motion was made by Mr. Gray, seconded by Ms. Hovest, to approve the bills as presented; non-payroll of \$126,412.83 and payroll of \$19,542.56 for a total of \$145,955.39. Voting: All Yea.

Motion was made by Mr. Fricke, seconded by Mr. Gray, to approve the Fund Summary, Bank Reconciliation and Bank Balance Reports for February, 2026. Voting: All Yea.

Motion was made by Mr. Gray, seconded by Mrs. Lammers, to approve the Revenue and Appropriation Summary Reports for February, 2026. Voting: All Yea.

Ordinance No. 622-2026: AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, ADOPTING, AND ENACTING AMERICAN LEGAL PUBLISHING'S OHIO BASIC CODE, 2026 EDITION, AS THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF PANDORA, OHIO. Motion was made by Mr. Gray, seconded by Mrs. Lammers, to approve the current credit card statement in the amount of \$312.70. Voting: All Yea.


