

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-747

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A CYBERSECURITY POLICY

Whereas, the State of Ohio has implemented Ohio Revised Code 9.64, enacted through HB96, requiring all local governments and jurisdictions to establish a cybersecurity policy, and

Whereas, the purpose of this requirement is to strengthen protections of public data, information systems, and technology resources from cybersecurity threats and risks; and

Whereas, a Cybersecurity Policy has been prepared and reviewed by the Council of the Village of Pandora, and is recommended for adoption for compliance with Ohio Revised Code 9.64 and HB 96; and

Whereas, the policy provides guidance on access control, system security, data protection, incident response, training, and vendor management.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Pandora, Putnam County, Ohio that:

1. The attached Cybersecurity Policy is hereby adopted as the official policy of the Village of Pandora.
2. The Fiscal Officer shall distribute the adoption policy to all village departments, employees, and relevant contractors.
3. This resolution shall be in force and effect upon its passage and adoption by the Village of Pandora Council.

That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the passage of this Resolution were passed in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that result in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


