# WELCOME TO CIA

Welcome to Cheer Infinity Allstars.

We are proud that you have chosen to be part of our program.

At CIA, our mission is to develop athletes who are confident, disciplined, and team-oriented. We train athletes to perform at a high level while demonstrating integrity, accountability, and composure both on and off the mat.

# THE CIA STANDARD

At Cheer Infinity Allstars, we operate with a clear and consistent standard.

This standard defines the expectations for every athlete and family in our program.

Participation in CIA is not casual. It is a **full-season, team-first commitment**.

## COMMITMENT

- CIA is the athlete's **primary extracurricular activity**
- The season runs **May through April**
- All athletes are expected to fully participate through the end of the season

## ATTENDANCE

- Athletes are expected to attend **all practices, competitions, and scheduled events**
- Absences are limited and must follow program policy
- No absences are permitted:
  - During choreography
  - The week of competition
  - During mandatory practices

Consistent attendance is essential to team success.

## TEAM-FIRST MINDSET

- Every decision is made in the best interest of the **team and the program**
- Roles and positions may change based on team needs
- Athletes are expected to support the team regardless of role

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## **EFFORT & ACCOUNTABILITY**

- Arrive on time and prepared
- Maintain focus and effort
- Accept coaching and apply corrections

Growth is directly tied to consistency and work ethic.

## **CONDUCT**

CIA maintains a **positive, disciplined, and respectful environment**

- Respect for coaches, teammates, and other programs
- Positive representation of CIA in person and on social media
- Professional behavior at all events

Negativity, gossip, or disruptive behavior will not be accepted.

## **FAMILY ALIGNMENT**

Families are expected to:

- Support program structure and decisions
- Communicate through appropriate channels
- Uphold the same standards of respect and professionalism

## **THE EXPECTATION**

CIA is designed for athletes and families who are committed to:

- Consistency
- Accountability
- Team success

If these standards align with your goals, you will thrive in this program.

## **FINAL NOTE**

By participating in Cheer Infinity Allstars, you are choosing to be held to this standard.

# TRYOUT PROCESS & REQUIREMENTS

## TRYOUT PROCESS

Participation in tryouts requires completion of registration, submission of required documents, and payment of all applicable fees.

## REGISTRATION

- **New Athletes:** Must register online through the Cheer Infinity Allstars website prior to tryouts
- **Returning Athletes:** Must log into the Client Portal and update all required policies prior to tryouts

## TRYOUT FEES & INITIAL PAYMENT

The following is due at time of sign up:

- \$70 Registration Fee (new athletes only)
- \$155 May Tryout Fee
- Remaining May tuition (as outlined in payment schedule)

## IMPORTANT

Participation in tryouts is considered a commitment to the program.

- If an athlete chooses not to join after tryouts, all payments made are **non-refundable**
- Team placements and program decisions are made based on committed athletes

## REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

The following must be submitted at tryouts:

- Evaluation Form (top portion completed)
- Terms & Conditions (signed and dated)
- Buyout Contract (signed and dated)
- Athlete Information Form (completed and signed)

Incomplete submissions may delay or prevent team placement.

# TEAM PLACEMENT PHILOSOPHY

## TEAM PLACEMENT

Cheer Infinity Allstars follows all **USASF guidelines** for team structure and eligibility.

Team placement is based on the **complete athlete**, not solely tumbling ability.

## EVALUATION CRITERIA

Placement decisions are based on a combination of:

- Tumbling skill and execution
- Stunting ability and position (base, flyer, back spot)
- Flexibility and body control
- Jumps, motions, and overall performance
- Attitude, coachability, and work ethic
- Age requirements
- Team structure and program needs

## IMPORTANT PLACEMENT NOTES

- Athletes may be placed on teams where skill levels vary
- Not all athletes will contribute in the same areas
- Some athletes may be stronger in tumbling, others in stunting or performance

All placement decisions are made based on what best supports:

👉 The **team**

👉 The **overall program**

## FINAL DECISIONS

- Team placements are final
- Adjustments may be made throughout the season if needed to support team success

## PROGRAM TRUST

Every athlete is placed intentionally and for a specific role.

Families are expected to trust the experience and judgment of the coaching staff in making placement decisions.

## SECTION 5

# PROGRAM COST OVERVIEW

## PROGRAM COST OVERVIEW

Participation in the CIA Elite Program includes multiple components that together make up the total program cost.

### BASE TUITION

**\$155 per month**

This covers:

- Two 2-hour team practices per week
- **All scheduled extra practices throughout the season**

👉 No additional fees are charged for extra practices that are part of the program schedule.

### ADDITIONAL PROGRAM COSTS (BUNDLED INTO MONTHLY PAYMENT)

In addition to base tuition, the following required program costs are distributed across the season and included in your total monthly payment:

- Competition Fees
- Practice Wear
- Choreography
- Music
- Coaches Fees

### TOTAL MONTHLY PAYMENT

All program costs (excluding April) are combined and divided into equal monthly payments.

#### Single Competitor

👉 **\$450 per month (May–March)**

#### Double Competitor

👉 **\$590 per month (May–March)**

### SIBLING DISCOUNT

- A **\$20 monthly discount** is applied for each additional athlete within the same family

## DOUBLE COMPETITORS

- There is **no additional tuition fee** for double competitors
- However, **additional competition fees and choreography fees do apply**
- These additional costs are **already reflected in the double competitor monthly payment schedule**

## APRIL TUITION

👉 **April is base tuition only: \$155**

- April does **not** include bundled program costs
- April reflects practice time and final season preparation

## WHAT YOUR MONTHLY PAYMENT (MAY–MARCH) INCLUDES

- Team practices
- All scheduled extra practices
- Competition entry fees
- Choreography and music
- Coaching fees
- Practice wear

## WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED IN MONTHLY PAYMENT

The following are separate and not included:

- **Uniform Package**
- Tumbling Classes (\$55/month per class, if enrolled)
- Stunt Class (\$80/month, if enrolled)
- Cheer Shoes
- Competition Makeup
- Travel & Hotel Expenses

## TUMBLING CLASSES

It is **highly encouraged** that athletes enroll in a tumbling class outside of their scheduled team practice time.

- Allstar athletes receive a **discounted rate of \$55 per month per tumbling class**
- Classes should be selected based on the athlete's current skill level and progression goals

Tumbling is a key component of athlete development and contributes directly to overall performance and team success.

## UNIFORM PACKAGE

- Total Cost: **\$605**
- **Payment 1:** June 15 – \$302.50
- **Payment 2:** July 15 – \$302.50
- Includes bow (hair piece)

If an athlete already owns a current uniform:

- Replacement pieces may be purchased individually

## IMPORTANT FINANCIAL STRUCTURE

- Season runs **May through April**
- **May–March:** Full program payments (\$450 / \$590)
- **April:** Base tuition only (\$155)

## PAYMENT POLICIES

- Payments are drafted on the **1st of each month**
- A valid payment method must remain on file

### *SECTION 6*

## LATE PAYMENT POLICY

### LATE PAYMENT POLICY

All payments are due on the **1st of each month**.

A valid payment method must remain on file at all times.

### LATE FEES

**A \$15 late fee will be applied on the 10th of the month to any account with an outstanding balance.**

### PAST DUE ACCOUNTS

We understand that situations may arise; however, consistent payment is required to maintain participation in the program.

#### **10+ Days Past Due**

- A late fee will be applied
- The account will be considered past due
- Participation status may be reviewed
- 🖱️ While athletes are typically allowed to continue participating, Cheer Infinity reserves the right to **limit or restrict participation** for accounts that are not being responsibly maintained.

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**30+ Days Past Due**

- The account will be formally reviewed
- The athlete **may be removed from the program**
- The account may be sent to collections if not resolved

**PROGRAM EXPECTATION**

Families are expected to:

- Maintain current accounts
- Communicate proactively if an issue arises
- Resolve balances in a timely manner

Failure to do so may result in removal from the program.

*SECTION 7***COMMITMENT, ATTENDANCE & PROGRAM ENFORCEMENT****FULL SEASON COMMITMENT**

Participation in Cheer Infinity Allstars is a **full-season commitment (May–April)**.

By accepting placement on a team, athletes and families are committing to:

- The full competition season
- All practices, events, and competitions
- The financial obligations associated with the program

**BUYOUT POLICY**

All payments are non-refundable.

If an athlete leaves the program, is removed, or is unable to continue participation, the following buyout policy applies:

**BEFORE CHOREOGRAPHY**

- A **\$500 buyout fee** will be applied

**FROM CHOREOGRAPHY THROUGH END OF SEASON (INCLUDING SUMMIT)**

- A **\$800 buyout fee** will be applied

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## **IMPORTANT BUYOUT NOTES**

- Buyout fees apply **per team** for double competitors
- Competition fees already paid will be used toward:
  - Replacement athletes
  - Routine adjustments and re-choreography
- Athletes who leave the program may not be eligible to return the following season

## **ATTENDANCE POLICY**

Attendance is critical to team success and routine consistency.

### **ABSENCE LIMIT**

- Athletes are allowed a maximum of **6 absences per season**

### **ABSENCE REPORTING**

- All absences must be reported through the **Front Desk**
- Do not report absences directly to coaches
- Do not report absences to the Allstar Director

This ensures:

- Proper documentation of attendance
- Consistent communication across the program
- Accurate tracking for attendance policies

Coaches will be notified by staff.

### **UNEXCUSED ABSENCES**

Exceeding the allowed number of absences may result in:

- Removal from the team
- No refunds
- Buyout policy applied

## **MANDATORY ATTENDANCE PERIODS**

The following are **non-negotiable and cannot be missed**:

- Choreography camps
- The week of any competition
- Scheduled extra practices
- April practices (final competition preparation)

## VACATIONS

Families are expected to schedule vacations during **designated gym closing dates**.

- Gym closing dates are provided in advance within this handbook
- These are the appropriate times for extended time away

Vacations scheduled outside of these designated periods will be treated as absences and must follow the attendance policy.

## PRE-COMPETITION EXPECTATIONS

- Missing practice within **1 week of a competition** may result in:
  - Removal from portions of the routine
  - Full removal from the performance

These decisions are made at the discretion of the coaching staff and in the best interest of the team.

## IMPORTANT

If an athlete is removed from the performance, this will be considered a **missed competition**.

A missed competition will result in:

- **Immediate removal from the program**
- **No refunds**
- **Buyout policy being applied**

## COMPETITION REQUIREMENT

All competitions are mandatory!

Missing a competition will result in:

- Immediate removal from the program
- No refunds
- Buyout policy applied

## PRIORITY EXPECTATION

CIA must be the athlete's **primary extracurricular activity**.

- Practices and competitions may not be missed for:
  - Other sports
  - School activities
  - Schedule conflicts

Failure to prioritize CIA may result in removal from the program.

## PARENT-ENFORCED ABSENCES

Cheerleading may not be withheld as a form of punishment.

- Removing an athlete from practice impacts:
  - Their development
  - Their team's performance

Repeated conflicts of this nature may result in dismissal from the program.

## FINAL EXPECTATION

This program is structured for athletes and families who are committed to:


- Consistency
- Accountability
- Team success

If these expectations are not aligned, the program may not be the right fit.

### SECTION 8

## COMPETITIONS & TRAVEL

### COMPETITION REQUIREMENT

 *All competitions are mandatory. Please refer to Section 7: Commitment, Attendance & Program Enforcement for full policy details and consequences.*

### TRAVEL RESPONSIBILITY

All travel and accommodations are the responsibility of each family.

This includes:

- Transportation
- Hotel accommodations
- Meals
- Any additional travel-related expenses

### STAY-TO-PLAY EVENTS

Some competitions require participation in a **Stay-to-Play** program.

- These events require booking accommodations through designated housing providers
- Stay-to-Play events will be clearly identified on the competition schedule

Families are responsible for complying with all Stay-to-Play requirements when applicable.

## COMPETITION EXPECTATIONS

When attending competitions, athletes are expected to:

- Arrive on time and fully prepared
- Wear the complete required uniform, including:
  - Uniform
  - Bow
  - Cheer shoes
  - Warm-up (when required)
- Follow all appearance guidelines (hair, makeup, etc.)
- Remain with the team as instructed
- Stay through awards

## PROGRAM REPRESENTATION

All athletes and families represent Cheer Infinity Allstars at competitions.

Expected behavior includes:

- Respect toward coaches, staff, judges, and other programs
- Positive sportsmanship at all times
- Supporting all CIA teams

Families are encouraged to:

- Sit together
- Support all CIA athletes
- Represent the program in a positive and unified manner

## SUPERVISION REQUIREMENT

- All athletes must be accompanied by a responsible adult at competitions
- Athletes are not permitted to attend competitions without supervision

## APRIL COMPETITION PERIOD

April is a critical competition period.

- All practices during this time are **mandatory**
- Schedules must remain open

Missing April practices may result in:

- Removal from performances
- Ineligibility for postseason events (including Summit)
- Buyout policy applied

# COMMUNICATION STRUCTURE

## COMMUNICATION EXPECTATION

Clear communication is essential for a successful season.

Parents are responsible for:

- Staying informed
- Checking communication regularly
- Maintaining updated contact information

## PRIMARY COMMUNICATION CHANNELS

### EMAIL

- Official communication from the gym
- Policies, schedules, and important updates

### GROUP COMMUNICATION (GROUPME)

- Team-specific updates and reminders
- Quick communication for schedules and logistics

👉 This platform is not intended for extended discussions or concerns

### TEAM MOMS

Team Moms assist with:

- Passing along information
- Competition-day coordination
- Team logistics

Team Moms:

- Do not make program decisions
- Do not replace communication with staff

## QUESTIONS & CONCERNS

All questions or concerns should be directed to:

👉 **Allstar Director (via email)**

- Meetings will be scheduled if needed
- Communication should follow proper channels

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## ABSENCE REPORTING

All absences must be reported through the **Front Desk**.

- Do **not** report absences directly to coaches
- Do **not** report absences to the Allstar Director

This ensures:

- Proper documentation of attendance
- Consistent communication across the program
- Accurate tracking for attendance policies

Coaches will be notified by staff.

## RESPONSE EXPECTATION

- Please allow **24–48 hours** for responses
- Immediate responses are not guaranteed

## STAFF BOUNDARIES

- Do not contact coaches or staff on personal phones
- Communication should go through:
  - Email
  - Front Desk

👉 This ensures clear, professional communication and protects staff time

### *SECTION 10*

## PRACTICE EXPECTATIONS

### PRACTICE RESPONSIBILITY

Athletes are expected to arrive:

- On time
- Fully prepared
- Ready to begin practice immediately

This includes:

- Hair secured
- Proper practice attire
- Cheer shoes on

## DRESS CODE

A practice wear schedule will be provided monthly.

- Athletes are expected to wear the assigned practice attire
- Dress code must be followed at all practices

Failure to meet dress code expectations may result in conditioning.

## PUNCTUALITY

- Athletes must be on time and ready to start practice
- Late arrivals may result in conditioning

Consistent tardiness may impact participation status.

## EXTRA PRACTICES

- Extra practices are scheduled in advance and are **mandatory**
- Additional practices may be added at the discretion of the coaching staff

These practices are considered part of the program and must be attended.

## CLOSED PRACTICES

Coaches reserve the right to close practices at any time.

- Parents and spectators are not permitted on the floor
- Practice time is reserved for athlete development

## SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- All jewelry must be removed prior to practice
- Athletes who choose to wear stud earrings do so at their own risk

Cheer Infinity is not responsible for damage or injury resulting from failure to follow safety guidelines.

### *SECTION II*

## ATHLETE & FAMILY CONDUCT

### PROGRAM ENVIRONMENT

Cheer Infinity Allstars maintains a positive, disciplined, and respectful environment.

All athletes and families are expected to contribute to this standard.

## **CIA STANDARD OF SPORTSMANSHIP**

Cheer Infinity Allstars is known for maintaining a high standard of sportsmanship across all areas of the program.

This includes:

- Athletes
- Parents
- Staff

We take pride in being recognized for:

- Respectful behavior toward other teams and programs
- Professional interactions with event staff and judges
- Positive representation at competitions and events

This standard is a core part of the CIA culture and is expected to be upheld at all times.

**Families and athletes are expected to uphold and contribute to this reputation.**

## **EXPECTATIONS**

The following are required at all times:

- Respect toward coaches, staff, athletes, and other programs
- Positive attitude and sportsmanship
- Professional behavior at practices, competitions, and events

## **PROHIBITED BEHAVIOR**

The following will not be tolerated:

- Gossip or negativity
- Disrespectful language or behavior
- Inappropriate social media posts
- Public criticism of the program, staff, or other teams

## **ENFORCEMENT**

Cheer Infinity reserves the right to remove any athlete or family from the program for behavior that:

- Disrupts the team environment
- Misrepresents the program
- Does not align with CIA standards

*SECTION 12***INJURY POLICY****MEDICAL RESPONSIBILITY**

All athletes must have personal medical insurance.

If an injury occurs:

- It is the responsibility of the parent to seek medical evaluation

**RETURN TO PARTICIPATION**

- A doctor's release is required for return after significant injury
- Athlete participation will follow medical guidance

**FINANCIAL POLICY**

- No refunds will be issued due to injury
- Program costs will continue as scheduled

*SECTION 13***UNIFORMS & APPEARANCE****RESPONSIBILITY**

Athletes are responsible for maintaining all program-issued items, including:

- Uniform
- Practice wear
- Warm-ups

**REPLACEMENT**

Lost or damaged items must be replaced at the athlete's expense.

## **COMPETITION APPEARANCE**

Athletes must follow all appearance requirements at competitions:

- Full uniform
- Bow
- Cheer shoes
- Required hair and makeup

Uniforms must be worn at awards.

## **UNIFORM CYCLE**

Uniforms are updated on a rotating cycle as determined by the program.

### *SECTION 14*

## **FACILITY POLICIES**

### **GYM ACCESS**

- Only athletes and staff are permitted on the practice floor
- Parents and spectators must remain in designated viewing areas

### **DISRUPTIONS**

- Do not open gym doors or communicate through viewing windows during practice
- All communication should go through the Front Desk

### **PERSONAL ITEMS**

- Do not bring valuables to the gym
- Cheer Infinity is not responsible for lost or stolen items

### **ANIMALS**

No animals are permitted in the facility.

*SECTION 15*

# STAFF COMMUNICATION BOUNDARIES

## COMMUNICATION EXPECTATION

Staff communication should remain professional and structured.

## BOUNDARIES

- Do not call or text coaches on personal phones for general communication
- All standard communication should go through:
  - Email
  - Front Desk

## EXCEPTIONS

We understand that certain situations may require more immediate communication.

- In **urgent situations**, it is appropriate to contact a coach directly

However, this should be:

- Used **sparingly**
- Reserved for situations that require immediate attention

## PURPOSE

These guidelines ensure:

- Clear and consistent communication
- Respect for staff time
- A professional structure across the program

*SECTION 16*

# TEAM MOMS

## ROLE OF TEAM MOMS

Team Moms assist with:

- Communication support
- Competition logistics
- Coordinating team information

## LIMITATIONS

Team Moms:

- Do not make program decisions
- Do not replace communication with staff

All concerns should be directed to the appropriate staff member.

*SECTION 17*

# BOOSTER CLUB

## BOOSTER CLUB

Cheer Infinity Allstars does not operate an official booster club.

There may be an independently organized booster group available to families. Additional information will be provided by the individuals managing that group.

## IMPORTANT

- The booster club operates independently from Cheer Infinity Allstars
- Participation is optional
- Cheer Infinity Allstars is not responsible for booster club operations, decisions, or financial management

*SECTION 18*

# NONPARTICIPANTS

## NONPARTICIPANTS

For the safety and focus of all athletes:

- Parents, siblings, and guests are not permitted on the practice floor unless invited by staff
- Do not attempt to communicate with athletes during practice through doors or viewing areas
- Do not open gym doors during practice

## COMMUNICATION DURING PRACTICE

If you need to reach your athlete:

👉 Please go through the **Front Desk**

This ensures:

- Minimal disruption to training
- Safety of all athletes
- Consistency across all classes and teams

Failure to follow these guidelines may result in being asked to leave the facility.

## **CIA LOGO & BRAND USE**

The Cheer Infinity Allstars name, logo, and team logos are proprietary and protected.

## **MERCHANDISE POLICY**

- Families are not permitted to create, sell, or distribute items using:
  - The CIA name
  - CIA logos
  - Team logos
- All official merchandise must be purchased through Cheer Infinity Allstars or approved sources

## **PURPOSE**

This policy ensures:

- Brand consistency
- Quality control
- Protection of the Cheer Infinity Allstars identity

# CHEER INFINITY ALLSTARS

## BUYOUT CONTRACT AGREEMENT

This Buyout Contract Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into by and between the undersigned parent(s)/guardian(s) and Cheer Infinity Allstars ("CIA"). By signing below, the parent(s)/guardian(s) acknowledge and agree to the following terms:

**1. NON-REFUNDABLE PAYMENTS.** All payments made to CIA, including but not limited to tuition, competition fees, practice wear, uniforms, choreography, and any other program-related costs, are strictly non-refundable. Payments are not subject to proration or refund under any circumstances, including but not limited to illness, injury, voluntary withdrawal, dismissal, schedule conflicts, or reduced participation.

**2. EARLY WITHDRAWAL OR DISMISSAL.** In the event that an athlete voluntarily withdraws from the program or is dismissed for any reason prior to the completion of the season, all payments made shall be forfeited, and the applicable buyout fee shall become immediately due and payable.

**3. BUYOUT FEE STRUCTURE.** The following buyout fees apply based on the date of withdrawal or dismissal:

- May 24 through Choreography: **\$500 per team**
- Choreography through End of Season (including April and May Summit events): **\$800 per team**

**4. DOUBLE COMPETITORS.** For athletes participating on multiple teams, buyout fees shall be assessed on a **per team** basis.

**5. ENFORCEMENT.** Buyout fees are binding and enforceable regardless of the reason for withdrawal or dismissal. Failure to satisfy outstanding balances, including buyout fees, may result in suspension of participation, denial of future registration, and/or collection action.

**6. FUTURE ELIGIBILITY.** Any athlete who withdraws or is dismissed after the commencement date of this Agreement shall not be eligible to participate in tryouts or re-enroll in the program for the following season.

**7. ACKNOWLEDGMENT.** By signing below, the parent(s)/guardian(s) acknowledge that they have read, understood, and voluntarily agree to all terms outlined in this Agreement, and understand that this Agreement is binding and non-negotiable.

# CHEER INFINITY ALLSTARS

## TERMS & CONDITIONS AGREEMENT

*Please initial each statement and sign below acknowledging agreement to all terms.*

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that by trying out and paying the \$70 registration fee and \$155 Tryout Fee / May Tuition, I am committing to being placed on a team. If I choose not to accept placement after tryouts, all payments made will be forfeited, including registration, tryout fees, and May tuition.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that all monthly tuition fees are due and will be automatically drafted on the **1st of each month** with no exceptions.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that I am responsible for maintaining a valid credit card or bank account on file at all times and will immediately provide updated information if any changes occur.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that **all competition fees are non-refundable**.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that if my account becomes **10+ days past due**, a late fee will be applied and the account will be considered past due, and participation status may be reviewed.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that if my account becomes **30+ days past due**, my athlete may be removed from the program, and the **Buyout Contract will be enforced**.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand and agree to the absence policy. If an athlete exceeds the allowed number of absences, they may be removed from the team with **no refunds**, and the **Buyout Contract will apply**.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that competitive cheerleading is a team sport and that practices may not be withheld as punishment for behavior outside of the gym. Doing so may result in dismissal from the team. **Attendance is critical to team success**.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that **Choreography Camp is mandatory**, and that the coaching staff reserves the right to close practices as deemed necessary.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that **all competitions are mandatory**, and that missing a competition will result in dismissal from the team.
