Invoices

May we remind parents that you will **NOT** receive a monthly invoice — unless you have acquired extra charges in the month previous, in which case you will get an extra charge invoice to be paid on top of your master invoice.

We would like to politely remind you that if you give notice to cancel some or all of your sessions, there is a 4-week notice period. We will then calculate a final/amended invoice based on the sessions you have used and the amount you have paid to date. As the payments are worked out on a pro rata basis, we need to ensure that you have paid for the correct number of sessions before leaving.

Drop Off

May we remind parents, that children must be dropped off at the door at breakfast club by a parent/guardian due to safeguarding reasons. Parents must walk to the door with children and be seen by a member of staff. The only exceptions are Year 6 children whom we have pre-arranged written permission that they can walk to school and enter club alone.
