Our Story

In early 2023, several mothers and grandmothers approached our founding priest, Fr. Mike Barry, with the heartfelt request: "Please pray for our children and grandchildren who no longer attend church or receive the Sacraments." Fr. Barry responded, "As parents and grandparents, you have God-given authority to intercede for your children. Your prayers are powerful. You pray for them." And our ministry was born.

Quickly, parents and grandparents began praying the Rescue Rosary (included in this guide) not only for their children, but also for siblings, parents, and other loved ones whose faith has weakened or grown dormant. Prayer groups began forming across the country, interceding for their loved ones. With Fr. Mike Barry leading the way, a non-profit corporation was formed to support these local ministry teams with resources.

This guide is designed to assist individuals in their mission to pray for the souls of their loved ones and to help community and parish leaders in recruiting, organizing, and sustaining prayer teams. This mission requires commitment! By participating, you join your prayers with countless others worldwide who are also praying for their loved ones. At Mary's CPR, we will pray for you and your intentions and ask that you pray for us. Offer the Rescue Rosary daily for your loved one who has strayed and witness the abundant graces

8. Conclude with 'The Memorare', "*Remember, O most gracious Virgin Mary, that never was it known that anyone who fled to thy protection, implored thy help, or sought thy intercession, was left unaided. Inspired by this confidence, I fly unto thee, O Virgin of virgins, my Mother. To thee do I come, before thee I stand, sinful and sorrowful. O Mother of the Word Incarnate despise not my petitions, but in thy mercy hear and answer me. Amen.*"

7. On each of the large 'Our Father' beads pray 'The Glory Be' and "*We adore you O Christ and we bless you because by your Holy Cross you have redeemed the world.*"



6. On each of the 10 Hail Mary beads pray "*Jesus said I died for you that you may live in me*"

5. Before each decade affirm "This prayer is for (Name)"

4. On the next large bead pray "Glory Be"

3. On the next three beads pray the 'Hail Mary'

2. On first large bead pray the 'Our Father'

1. Start with the sign of the cross followed by the 'Apostles Creed'

Prayer Meeting

Lighting of the Candle
Opening Prayer:

Almighty and merciful God, you created each of us and love us unconditionally, even when we stray from You. We ask for Your mercy upon our loved ones who have turned away from the grace found in the Sacraments. Shield them from evil influences and surround them with faith-filled companions who encourage their return to You. By the power of Your Holy Spirit, renew in them a desire to seek You, Lord. We ask this in the holy name of Jesus. Amen.

Each person names their loved ones aloud, with the group responding: "We lift him/her to You, Lord."

Leader's Prayer:

Lord Jesus Christ, by Your Cross and Resurrection, we ask You to break any evil forces that have led these loved ones away from You. Fill their hearts with Your Holy Spirit and guide them back to the Sacraments. In Your holy name, we pray. Amen.

All Pray the Rescue Rosary Together
Closing Prayer: The Lord's Prayer (Our Father)

Prayer of Reparation

(This prayer is most powerful when recited after receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation)

O Holy Spirit, guide fallen-away Catholics back to the Church and the Sacraments! We beg the intercession of Mary, Mother of God and our mother, to help our loved ones return to the Catholic Church and fervently embrace their Catholic Faith. We pray in Jesus' name. Amen.
