



COURT TIME POLICY

Junior Netball is designed to support and encourage participation of players and develop players to their full potential through diversity and enjoyment.

GENERAL FIXTURED GAMES

SET & GO

All SET & GO players will be rotated through all court positions to support skill development. Parents must not request that their child be restricted to only one or two positions in the SET & GO competitions. All SET & GO players will receive equal court time throughout the season.

Coaches and team managers are responsible for recording player positions and court time each week to ensure fair and equitable participation.

Parents must notify the coach as soon as possible if their child is unable to attend training or a game, as this impacts team planning.

JUNIOR, OPEN, MASTERS & PREMIER LEAGUE (ELIGIBLE FOR FINALS)

Players will begin to learn and develop skills for positions that best suit their individual development.

All players will receive equal court time during fixture games throughout the season, provided team expectations for training attendance and behaviour are met. Where these expectations are not met, court time may be reduced.

Coaches and team managers are responsible for recording court time and attendance each week to ensure fair and equitable participation.

Parents and/or players must notify the coach as soon as possible if they are unable to attend training or a game.

Any borrowed eligible player must not receive more court time than a registered team member.

FINAL SERIES

All eligible players must receive a minimum of 25% court time during the final series.

Allocation of court time during finals is at the coach's discretion. Performance, player combinations, positional requirements, attitude, and fitness may be considered when making these decisions.

Any borrowed eligible player must not receive more court time than a registered team member during the final series.
