Dear Praying friends and family,

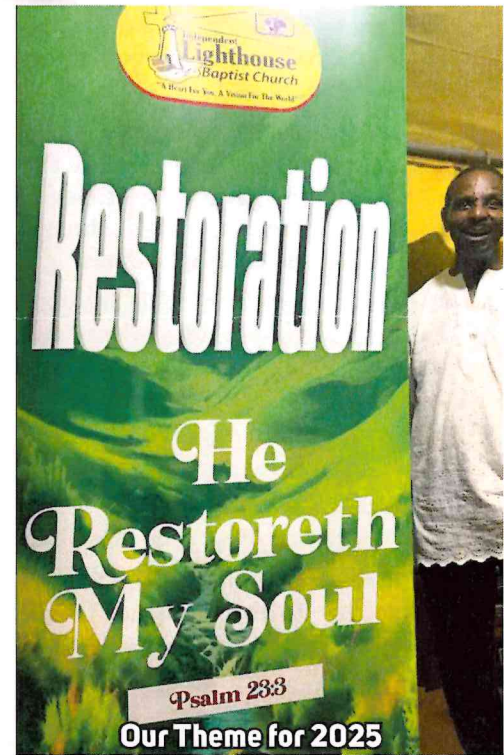

“Comfortable Together” marriage conference hosted by missionaries Dan Dwire and Tony Applegate of Faith Baptist Church in Uganda. Before going, we taught a mini marriage conference for our church members. The conference was a blessing to both the layman and pastors and their wives.

On March 11, at around 9 P.M. Mr. & Mrs. Prosper Sefogbe welcomed their first son into the world. Both mom and baby are doing well. Please pray for them as they make adjustment in their new found life and bundle of joy!

PRAISE REPORTS:

- We saw about 75 people accept the Lord as their personal Saviour as we attended the funeral of Mary Kpeglo, a student who came to know the Lord as she attended our literacy program.
- We were able to encourage about 25 widows in our Ashaiman community with KJV Bibles, discipleship books and the preaching of God’s Word. Every widow received food, clothes, shoes, toothbrushes and mosquito nets for their homes.
- We continue to have Bible institute classes on Thursday evenings. We have 13 students and one French student enrolled. The Lord is blessing our teaching, learning and study time!
- The social welfare director of our municipality has given us the documents we need to apply for a social welfare certificate for our Tema LEAP literacy program to be recognized and be in good standing.
- I was able to obtain my Ghana citizenship! This puts an end to the yearly challenges of dealing with immigration to obtain my resident permit. To God be the glory!!!

PRAYER REQUESTS:

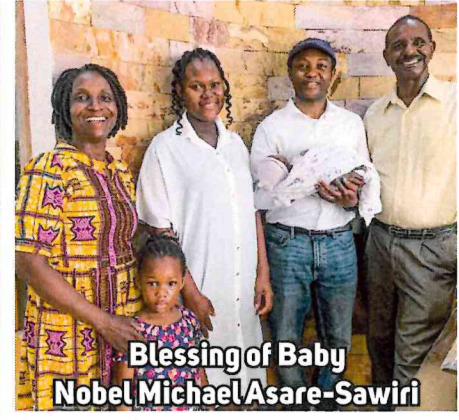
- Pray for God’s provision for our multiphase building project. The iLBC ladies fellowship has resumed the shawl project and continue to contribute their time and talents in making the shawls to support the project.
- We are preparing to attend the funeral of Oliver Habada, a young man for whom we have cared for the past eight years with epilepsy caused by Rasemussen Encephalitis. On the 5th of March, he underwent an emergency surgery to correct intestinal obstruction and did not revive. Pray for many souls to be saved as we travel to his village for his funeral on 5th April.

As always, thank you for giving us the privilege to be the extension of your hands to reaching souls for Christ here in Ghana, West Africa.

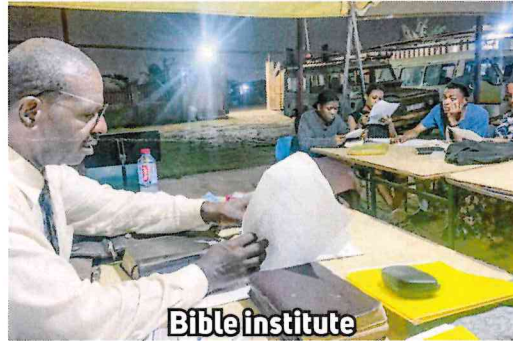

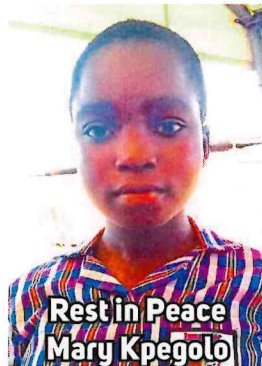

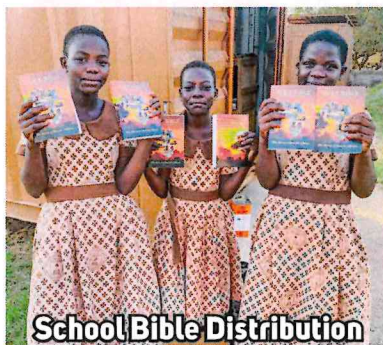

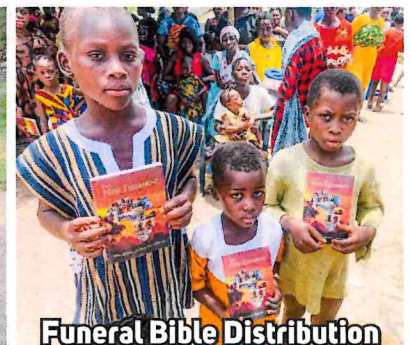
