Utilizing The Anchor of the Soul as a discipleship tool and our KJV Beam Bibles, we are equipping them to make disciples.

FAMILY: On March 6, I had the honor to officiate the marriage of our oldest son, Fredrick, to Mariana in Waco, Texas. We gained a new daughter! While at a barber shop, I had the opportunity to lead the barber, Robert, to the Lord. It was a double miracle! We were in need of a commercial kitchen to prepare West African dishes for the wedding. Robert, who is also a chef, made his commercial kitchen available for our use!

In January, Antoinette and her assistant had the opportunity to travel to Durban, South Africa, for intensive administrative training. Pray for us as we plan and prepare to convert our literacy program into LEAP Christian Academy using the Accelerated Christian Education curriculum.

MINISTRY: In January, we had our faith promise mission conference. I taught the eight principles of faith promise. Missionary Dwayne Harrison preached and challenged our people to give, pray and go as fishers of men. We are looking to support Brother Awumey of Rock of Ages prison ministries here in Ghana. Pray for the five missionaries we currently support. We presently have two church plants that are in need of full-time national pastors. Pray for the Lord to provide pastors for the work!

I had the opportunity to preach at the funeral of the sister of one of our church plants leader. The Gospel message went forth through the preaching and literature distribution. We saw six people accept Christ. We are reaching many young people for the Lord through our Tema Ridge school chapel and Bible club. Recently, as I was out soul winning and



distributing Johns and Romans, a former student extended words of encouragement. Evangelist Mike Pelletier came from North Carolina and preached our revival meeting. He encouraged and challenged our members to continue to be faithful in the service and work of the Lord. His last message on overcoming bitterness was impactful.

- We received and are distributing 1000 of The Heaven's Test gospel tracts from AAA ministries.
- We have the opportunity to distribute Bible Visual International Sunday School materials to ministries in need in West Africa.
- Our Bible institute has successfully completed the 36 lessons on the Great Doctrines of the Bible.
- The Lord provided a seasoned and humble volunteer music teacher for our LEAP students. A school orchestra has been birthed!

PRAYER REQUESTS:

- Please pray healing for Clementina, a young girl of our ministry who is battling mental illness since the sudden death of her mother. Pray for our visits and spiritual intervention to be successful and productive.
- We need a building to house the LEAP Christian Academy. Please pray as to how the Lord will lead you to give towards building the first phase of the four story educational building (\$150K).
- Our vehicle problems are endless. We have been left by the dangerous roadside multiple times. Our personal vehicle and two mini buses of the church are in disrepair. Thankfully, we have been approved to raise \$48K to replace our vehicles. Your help in giving towards this need will make it possible for us to travel safely to training meetings and conferences. We will also be able to resume our bus route to pick up the elderly and a crippled young man and his family for church services. We are thankful to those who have given towards this vehicle replacement project.

As always, thank you for partnering with us in prayer and support to spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ, make disciples and plant churches in Ghana-West Africa.

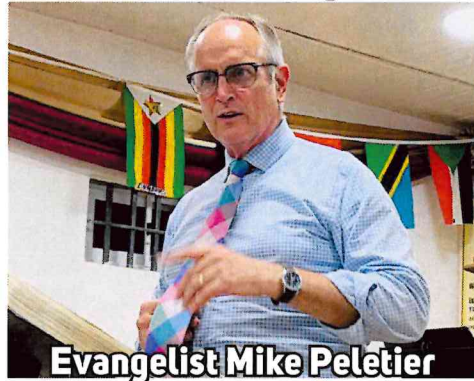

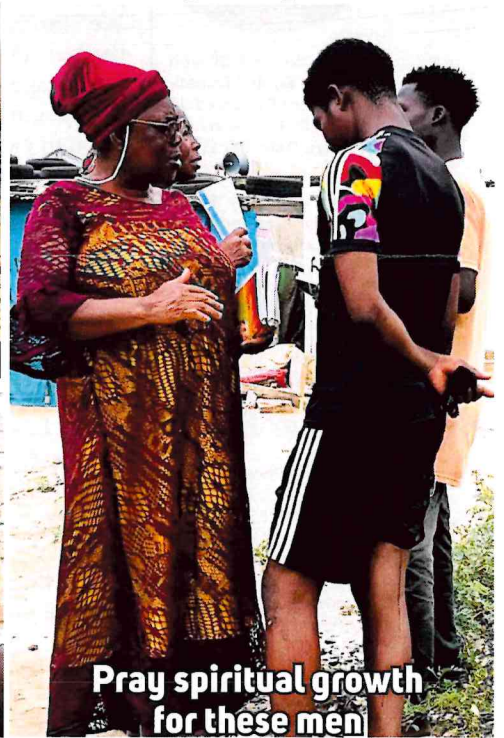

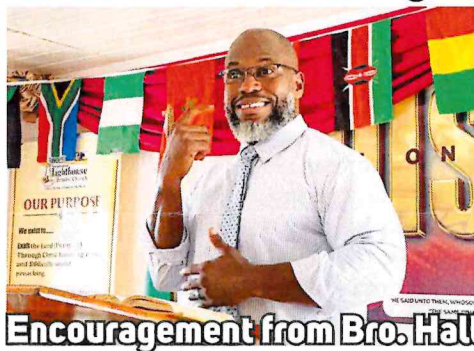
