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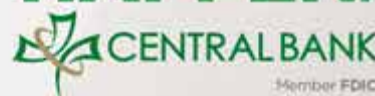

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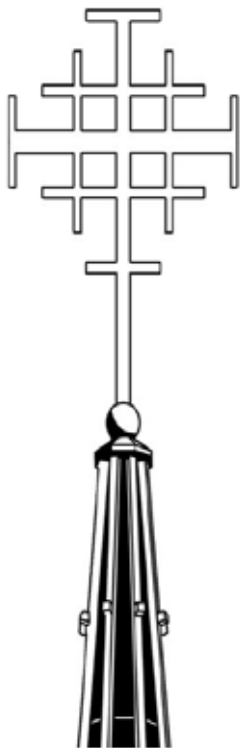

A Note From Fr. Hemann

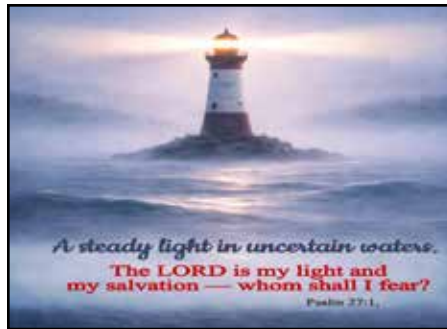
This Gospel is one of the most challenging passages because, at first reading, Jesus appears dismissive, even insulting. But the Church has long understood that something deeper is happening.

When Jesus says, "I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel," he is expressing the order of God's plan of salvation. The Messiah was promised first to Israel, and through Israel salvation would then reach all nations. This is not a statement that Gentiles are unworthy; it reflects the unfolding of God's saving plan.

Why does Jesus seem harsh?

The phrase about the children and the dogs troubles most readers: "It is not right to take the food of the children and throw it to the dogs."

In English it sounds severe. However, the Greek word used is not the word for wild scavenger dogs but little household dogs or puppies. The image is that of a family meal. The children are fed first; afterward even the pets share in the household's abundance.
