**JEFFERSON TOWNSHIP, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO
A RESOLUTION REQUESTING COUNTY AUDITOR CERTIFICATION FOR A PROPOSED ADDITIONAL THREE-MILL
CURRENT EXPENSES LEVY FOR THE GENERAL FUND**

The Board of Trustees of Jefferson Township, Montgomery County, Ohio, met at a special meeting on July 20, 2026, at 1:00p.m. at the Township Offices located at 1 Business Park Dr., Dayton, Ohio, with the following

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Jefferson Township, Montgomery County, Ohio, has determined that the amount of taxes that may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide for the necessary requirements of Jefferson Township for current expenses of the Township's General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that it is necessary to levy an additional tax outside the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of current expenses of Jefferson Township, to be credited to the General Fund, as authorized by Section 5705.19(A) of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees proposes that the tax be an additional levy in the amount of three (3) mills for each one dollar of taxable value, for a period of five (5) years, upon the entire territory of Jefferson Township; and

WHEREAS, Section 5705.03(B) of the Ohio Revised Code requires the taxing authority to certify to the County Auditor a resolution requesting that the County Auditor certify to the taxing authority the total current tax valuation of the subdivision and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the proposed levy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Jefferson Township, Montgomery County, Ohio:

1.- Necessity and Purpose. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it is necessary to levy an additional tax outside the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of current expenses of Jefferson Township, to be credited to the Township's General Fund, pursuant to Section 5705.19(A) of the Ohio Revised Code.

2.- Proposed Rate and Term. The proposed tax shall be an additional levy in the amount of three (3) mills for each one dollar of taxable value, for a period of five (5) years.

3.- **Territory.** The proposed tax shall be levied upon the entire territory of Jefferson Township, Montgomery County, Ohio, and the ballot measure shall be submitted to the electors of the entire territory of Jefferson Township.

4.- **Election.** The question of the proposed tax shall be placed upon the ballot at the General Election to be held on November 3, 2026.

5.- **First Tax Year and First Collection Year.** The proposed tax shall first be levied in tax year 2026 and shall first be collected in calendar year 2027.

6.- **County.** Jefferson Township is located in Montgomery County, Ohio.

7.- **Request to County Auditor.** In accordance with Section 5705.03(B) of the Ohio Revised Code, the Board of Trustees hereby requests that the Auditor of Montgomery County, Ohio, certify to the Board of Trustees the total current tax valuation of Jefferson Township, Montgomery County, Ohio, and the dollar amount of revenue, rounded to the nearest dollar, that would be generated by an additional three (3) mills for each one dollar of taxable value for the levy described in this Resolution.

8.- **Further Proceedings.** Upon receipt of the County Auditor's certification, the Board of Trustees may proceed in accordance with Section 5705.03(B) and Section 5705.19 of the Ohio Revised Code to determine whether to submit the question of the proposed tax levy to the electors.

9.- **Open Meetings.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of the Board of Trustees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Board of Trustees, and that all deliberations of the Board of Trustees and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

10.- **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.

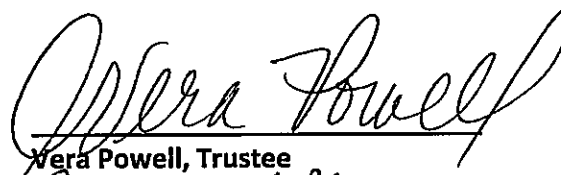

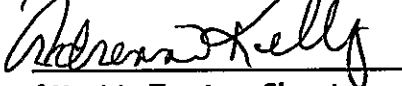
