WHEREAS, Resolution 26-012 was previously adopted by the Jefferson Township Board of Trustees authorizing increased hourly wages for part-time fire department employees based upon their qualifications, certifications, and assigned work schedules, in accordance with approved budgetary allocations; and

WHEREAS, certain part-time fire employees have transitioned from a shifted rotation schedule, thereby not meeting the qualifications for an increased hourly wage rate pursuant to Resolution 26-012; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds it necessary and appropriate to implement the applicable wage adjustments for those employees who fail to meet the established qualifications under Resolution 26-012; and

WHEREAS, the employees identified below are subject to an hourly wage decrease in accordance with the applicable provision of Resolution 26-012;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Trustees of Jefferson Township, Montgomery County, Ohio, that the hourly wage rates for the following part-time fire department employees are hereby adjusted as follows:
