RESOLUTION NO 26-108

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF LEVYING AN ADDITIONAL TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF CURRENT EXPENSES AND SUBMITTING THE QUESTION OF SUCH LEVY TO THE ELECTORS OF JEFFERSON TOWNSHIP, OHIO, AT THE NOVEMBER 3, 2026 GENERAL ELECTION

The Board of Trustees of Jefferson Township, Montgomery County, Ohio, met at a special meeting on July 23, 2026, at 1:00 p.m. at the Township Offices located at 1 Business Park Dr., Dayton, Ohio, with the following members present:

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Jefferson Township, Montgomery County, Ohio, has determined that the amount of taxes that may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide for the necessary requirements of Jefferson Township for current expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that it is necessary to levy an additional tax outside the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of current expenses of Jefferson Township, the proceeds of which shall be credited to the Township's General Fund, as authorized by Section 5705.19(A) of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees previously adopted a resolution requesting that the Auditor of Montgomery County, Ohio certify the total current tax valuation of Jefferson Township and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the proposed levy; and

WHEREAS, the County Auditor has certified to this Board that the total taxable value of Jefferson Township used in calculating the estimated property tax revenue is \$112,627,497, that the estimated property tax revenue to be produced by the levy is \$337,882 annually, assuming constant valuation throughout the life of the levy, and that a levy of three (3.00) mills amounts to \$105 for each \$100,000 of the County Auditor's appraised value.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Jefferson Township, Montgomery County, Ohio, by vote of two-thirds of all members of the Board:

1.- **Necessity and Purpose.** The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it is necessary to levy an additional tax outside the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of current expenses of Jefferson Township, the proceeds of which shall be credited to the Township's General Fund, pursuant to Section 5705.19(A) of the Ohio Revised Code.

2.- **Rate.** The rate of the proposed tax levy shall be three (3.00) mills for each one dollar of taxable value, which amounts to \$105 for each \$100,000 of the County Auditor's appraised value, as estimated by the County Auditor.

3.- **Type of Levy.** The proposed tax shall be an additional levy.

4.- **Term.** The proposed tax shall be levied for a period of five (5) years.

5.- **Territory.** The proposed tax shall be levied upon the entire territory of Jefferson Township, Montgomery County, Ohio, and the question of the levy shall be submitted to the electors of the entire territory of Jefferson Township.

6.- **Election.** The question of the levy shall be submitted to the electors at the General Election to be held on November 3, 2026.

7.- **First Levy and Collection.** If approved by the electors, the tax shall first be levied in tax year 2026 and first collected in calendar year 2027.

8.- **Submission to Electors.** This Board shall proceed with the submission of the question of levying a three (3.00) mill tax outside the ten-mill limitation for the benefit of Jefferson Township, for the purpose of current expenses to be credited to the Township's General Fund, to the electors of Jefferson Township at the General Election to be held on November 3, 2026, in accordance with Section 5705.03(B)(3) and Section 5705.19 of the Ohio Revised Code.

9.- **Direction to Board of Elections.** The Montgomery County Board of Elections is hereby directed to place the question of such tax levy on the ballot at the General Election to be held on November 3, 2026.

10.- **Certification to Board of Elections.** The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this Resolution, together with a copy of the County Auditor's certification and a copy of the resolution previously certified to the County Auditor, to the Montgomery County Board of Elections in the manner and within the time prescribed by law.

11.- **Open Meetings.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of the Board of Trustees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Board of Trustees, and that all deliberations of the Board of Trustees and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

12.- **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.
