





OUR MISSION

Movement Based Learning When we are engaged in movement of the body, we are able to access multiple parts of our brain. When our students can access their brain and move their bodies simultaneously, they are in a state of mind ready for learning!

At Lit'l Duke we are extremely fortunate we have a huge place ready for us to integrate academics with movement, play, projects, creativity, and critical thinking!

Circle Time Is a special time to sing songs, listen to a story, or discuss the calendar and the theme presented in the class for that day.

School Time Learning through play encourages children to think, reason, question, and problem solve. Interactive learning includes math experiences, science explorations, creative art, music and movement, puzzles, dramatic play and language fundamentals. We provide a balance of child directed and teacher directed activities.

Bathroom Time Children learn the importance of self-hygiene and independent dressing skills, such as putting on socks and tying shoes.

Snack Time & Lunch Time All students receive a snack daily. Full Day students bring a lunch. Refrigerator, freezer, microwave on property.

Clean Up Everyone cleans together and prepares the next activity.

Gym Time All classes receive daily, beginning with 20 minutes of active play, enhancing gross motor and waking up the brain. We incorporate music, cooperative games, movement learning. Later in the day, a structured gym time uses gymnastics to increase core strength and basic gymnastic shapes and beginning gymnastic progressions.



"Lit'l Duke" Families have added value and learning opportunity with combined school and gymnastics. A GTG preschool gym class is 45 minutes per week at a cost of \$74 per month. A GTG kindergarten gym class is 1 hour per week at a cost of \$92 per month. Lit'l Duke students will receive 30 minutes per day of structured gym time with a certified gymnastics coach during our school hours. This is more than a \$100-200 monthly value included in our tuition!

Movement-Based Personalized Learning

Kickstart Camp

"Kickstart Camp", a summer program using movement to activate and affect change in the brain. Movement based education embodies four parts: body, space, relationship, and effort.

Students are given the opportunity to learn in a movement based environment to help stimulate their brains. This allows students to be engaged in the learning process, both physically and mentally, enhancing retention.

Each week will have a different theme. Crafts and activities will center around the weekly themes. Students daily schedule includes soft play, a morning warm up, carpet time, music, math, language arts, physical education, and more! Students utilize the awesome gym facility during multiple movement breaks to help keep students on task and engaged. They also take advantage of the great outdoors and beautiful weather as much as possible!

The Kickstart curriculum and themes follow and build off our high Lit'l Duke standards, ensuring your child will be more ready to enter preschool or kindergarten in the fall. In addition to a movement-based learning environment, curriculum meets state standards. Classroom projects and content will be tailored to a student's interests, making sure students are wanting to fully participate.

We use a combination of the following curriculums to provide students with a well-rounded foundation for school: Zoophonics, Learning without Tears, Starfall, and Opencourt.

We tweak and adjust our curriculum and lesson plans to meet students' specific needs, challenge them individually a little farther than they think they are capable of, and strive to create an environment where learning is an adventure!
