Uniform Items	Grades K-4	Grades 5-8
Pants/Slacks/Shorts	Navy blue dress pants <i>*No cargo, denim, athletic, or knit pants/shorts/skorts.</i>	Khaki dress pants <i>*No cargo, denim, athletic, or knit pants/shorts/skorts.</i>
Leggings for under skirts/jumpers	Solid navy	Solid navy, gray, or black
Shirts: Short or Long Sleeved	Light blue, navy blue, or burgundy polo. White blouse or white button-down for boys with tie. <i>*shirts must be tucked in at all times</i>	
Jumper/Dress/Skorts/Skirts <i>*no shorter than 2" above the knee</i>	Solid navy blue or uniform plaid	Solid uniform style khaki skirt
Shorts for under Skirt/Jumper/Dress	Solid navy, black or gray	
Socks	White, black or navy blue socks, knee socks, or tights	
Sweaters/Sweatshirts/Pull-over, Cardigan	Solid navy, white, or gray cardigan, pullover, or crewneck sweatshirt. Crewneck spirit wear sweatshirt. <i>*No hoodies or non-St. Mary School logos</i>	
Shoes	Athletic Shoes: black, white, gray, blue or black and white Leather or leather-like dress shoes: black, brown, tan, navy blue, or traditional saddle shoes Accents on shoes should be kept to a minimum <i>*Shoes that are not in uniform include: Boots, fashion boots, lighted shoes, shoes with roller skates, shoes with glitter or stones, Crocs, sandals/open toed shoes, heels over ¾". During winter months, boots worn to school must be changed and not worn in the classroom.</i>	
Spirit Wear	School spirit shirts may be worn on P.E. days and designated spirit days only.	
Hair Accessories/Jewelry	Hair must be of natural color. Highlights are only permitted if of a natural color. Drastic, fad hair colors are not permitted. Piercings (ears only): Small stud earrings, not dangling, for girls only. Other jewelry: One small/simple necklace and bracelet permitted.	
Makeup (girls only)	Makeup is not permitted. Nail polish is acceptable. Nails should be of a natural length and no fake nails.	Light, natural make-up permitted. Nail polish is acceptable. Nails should be of a natural length and no fake nails. No fake lashes.
Belts	Optional	Required if pants have belt loops; should be black, tan, brown, or navy

Additional Uniform Policy Notes

Uniform Fit and Condition

- Uniforms must be clean, neat, and properly fitted.
- Torn, stained, or excessively worn clothing is not acceptable.
- No cargo, denim, athletic, or knit pants/shorts/skorts.

Outerwear

- Coats, jackets, and hooded sweatshirts may not be worn in the classroom.
- During winter months, winter boots may not be worn in the classroom.
- Hats and bandanas are not permitted to be worn during the school day.

School Events

- School uniforms must be worn to Mass and on field trips or unless designated by the teacher.

Dress Down Policy

Category	Acceptable Attire	Prohibited Items
Tops	T-shirts, polos, or blouses with appropriate graphics or messages	Tank tops, crop tops, spaghetti straps, or shirts with offensive language or images
Bottoms	Jeans, casual pants, athletic wear, or modest-length shorts and skirts	Ripped jeans, leggings worn as pants, short shorts, or pajama pants
Footwear	Athletic shoes or casual shoes, Crocs in sport mode	Flip-flops, sandals, slippers
Accessories	Simple jewelry and hair accessories	Excessive jewelry, hats, or bandanas when indoors

Electronic Devices Policy

- All smart devices, *including cell phones, smartwatches, and smart glasses, must be powered off and stored in* student backpacks for the duration of the school day and extended care hours. Backpacks must remain in student lockers.
