For any decision involving less than \$1,500 in individual expenditures, those present shall constitute a quorum. If 20 members are not present, the measure will be put to electronic vote with all members of SSO eligible to cast a ballot. Ballots will be collected and counted within one week, a simple majority is required for the vote to pass.
