What is 'Rock Out Baby'?

What are the benefits?

Music is important in the early years, as it affects children's intelligence and emotions, and helps them develop their skills, including:

- Early language development
- An increased ability to learn foreign languages
- Improved mood and emotional regulation
 - Physical endurance
 - Patience and discipline
- Gross and fine motor skills, often honed through learning instruments like the drums
- Ability to recognize small differences between sounds (auditory discrimination)
- Cooperation and cross-cultural awareness
 - Improved memory and concentration
- Self-confidence, self-esteem, and self-expression, often built by learning how to overcome stage fright and perform
