

RENEWANATION Scholarships, and HCS Grants/Scholarships

Renewanation Scholarships

Families who have a student entering kindergarten or who are new to Heritage but were in a Kansas Public school or Public virtual school last year should apply to Renewanation for a scholarship. Families who qualify may be awarded a scholarship depending on available funds.

An eligible student means a child who:

(1) Resides in Kansas; and

(2)(A)(i) Has an annual family income that is less than or equal to 250% of the federal poverty guidelines as determined annually in the federal register by the United States department of health and human services under 42 U.S.C. § 9902(2); and

(2)(A)(ii) (a) was enrolled in kindergarten or any of the grades one through eight in any public school in the previous school year in which an educational scholarship is first sought for the child; or

(2)(A)(ii) (b) is eligible to be enrolled in any public school in the school year in which an educational scholarship is first sought for the child and the child is under the age of seven years; or

(2)(B) has received an educational scholarship under the program and has not graduated from high school or reached the age of 21 years.

Apply FIRST to Renewanation! Follow the steps below.

Once your Renewanation has been submitted, complete the HCS form.

Heritage Christian School Tuition Assistance Grants

Heritage Christian School Tuition Assistance Grants are offered on a first-come, first-served basis to students entering any grade.

The following information is required to process your application:

- Completed application for upcoming school year (open on March 1)
- Apply for Renewation and ACE scholarships if qualified.
- Copies of the previous year's tax forms.
- Copies of the previous year's W-2 forms for both spouses.
- We are accepting Tuition Assistance applications for the upcoming school year starting on March 1. The application is available upon request in the school office or by email at info@hcstopeka.org. The application for admission and tuition assistance documentation must be completed in order to be considered for a grant. The grants are limited and should be applied for as soon as possible.

The HCS Tuition Assistance Committee makes the final determination of tuition assistance awards. Our tuition assistance awards are tuition grants – a gift to your family – not a loan that needs to be repaid. HCS typically limits tuition grants to 10-30% of K-12 tuition charges.

Limited funding for additional hardship tuition grants may be available for unique, extenuating circumstances on a first come basis. Applicants should include a letter describing their situation in order to be considered for additional aid.
