### **Transparency is important to us**

While you are browsing our website **www. itochuitaliana.com** (the "**Site**") we may collect and process information about you through the use of cookies and other similar tools ("**cookies**").

The data controller of your personal data is Itochu Italiana S.p.A. a sole proprietorship company, part of the multinational group, with registered office in Milan, Via Ulrico Hoepli, 5, 20121 Milan, Italy (hereinafter referred to as "**Data Controller**" or "**Itochu**").

### **Background**

This Cookie Policy forms an integral part of our **Privacy Policy** and contains important information about the type and purpose of the cookies we install and how you can authorise, block or delete (in whole or in part) cookies through specific functions in your browser or through third-party add-ons.

You can consult our **Privacy Policy** for further detailed information on how we process your personal data, the recipients with whom we share your data and the rights you can exercise.

**This cookie policy must be read in conjunction with the Site's consent management panel, which provides detailed information on the cookies used. The consent management panel is available here.**

### **What are cookies, what information do they collect and which categories do we use**

A cookie is a small text file that is sent to the browser and saved on the user's terminal when the latter visits a website. Cookies can be used for different purposes (computer authentication, session monitoring, storing information on specific configurations concerning users accessing the server, storing preferences, etc.).

The cookies used by the Site collect information about users:

- IP address;
- information on the device in use (e.g. model, operating system, browser);
- date and time of access to the Site.

We use cookies to collect information about your navigation on the Site, to remember your language preferences, to allow web pages to load faster, to facilitate the use of online content and other various services (e.g. filling out forms), to create statistics that allow us to measure Site traffic and understand how users use the Site, which pages are visited most or least, how many users are on the Site, how much time is spent on the Site by the average user and how visitors access the Site, as well as to show you personalised advertising messages, i.e. in line with the preferences you showed when browsing the web.



In line with the applicable legislation on the use of cookies, your prior consent is not required for technical cookies. The legal basis for the processing is the performance of services requested directly by you.

To install analytical and profiling cookies we ask for your consent.

**Cookies may be installed directly by our Site (so-called first-party cookies) or they may be installed by other websites (so-called third-party cookies).**

**Our Site uses cookies and other tracking tools, as described and specified in the consent management panel. The consent management panel - through which you can always change your choices in relation to cookies - is available here.**

### **Type of cookies and other tracking tools**

#### **Technical Cookies**

These cookies are necessary for the operation of the Site and cannot be disabled on our systems. They are usually only set in response to your actions on the Site that corresponds to a request for services, such as when you set your privacy and language preferences, login or fill out a form. You can set your browser to block or receive alerts about these cookies, but some parts of the Site may not work.

#### **Analytical Cookies**

These cookies allow us to understand how users use the Site, so that we can evaluate how it works and improve the browsing experience and services offered to users. For example, these cookies allow us to know which pages are visited most or least, how many visitors are on the Site, how much time is spent on the Site by the average user and how visitors access the Site. Third-party analytical cookies used by the Site allow us to identify users and track their browsing of the Site. We ask for your consent to install such cookies.

#### **Social Media Button**

The Site also incorporates Social Media Buttons in order to allow greater user interaction and facilitate the sharing of content on social media. The Site incorporates Social Media Buttons of the following social media: Facebook and Twitter.

When the user clicks on the Social Media Button, the browser connects to the servers of the social network to which the Social Media Button is connected; if you use such button the social media can track the visit to the Site and, where appropriate, associate it with your social media account, particularly if the user is logged in at the time of the visit. If the user does not wish the social network to record data relating to the visit to the Site, he must log out of the social media account and delete the cookies that the social media has installed in the user's browser.

In relation to certain activities, the Data Controller and the social media platforms may also act as joint data controllers, pursuant to Article 26 of the GDPR, in particular when the Data Controller, through a Social Media Button, jointly determines with the social the purposes and means of the processing consisting of the collection and transmission of user data to



the social. The Data Controller, in such cases, adheres to the contractual conditions of the social, which may include joint controllership agreements.

### **You can choose whether and which cookies to authorise**

In line with the applicable legislation on the use of cookies, your prior consent is not always required. In particular, such consent is not required for technical cookies while it is required for other categories of cookies. When you access any page of the Site, you will see a Banner containing short cookie information, through which you can accept all cookies or manage your preferences regarding the use of cookies. Consent to the use of cookies is recorded via a technical cookie. From the Banner, you can also choose to manage your preferences for different categories of cookies, as well as find out the list of third parties who may install cookies on your device, by clicking on "**Manage Preferences**".

If you close the Banner by clicking on the X command, no cookies will be installed on your device, except for technical cookies, which are necessary for the operation of the Site.

You may also authorise, block or delete (in whole or in part) cookies through specific functions of your browser or through third-party add-ons. However, deactivating the Site's technical cookies may mean that some of the Site's services or functionalities will not be available or may not function properly and you may have to change or enter certain information manually or on each visit.

### **Data Transfer**

The personal data collected may be transferred to some non-EU countries. In this case, where the third country is not covered by an Adequacy Decision of the European Commission, the Data Controller undertakes to ensure adequate levels of protection and safeguards, such as contractual safeguards, in accordance with the applicable laws, including the execution of standard contractual clauses referred to in Article 46(2)(c) of the GDPR, supplemented by additional measures necessary to ensure that the level of

### **Persistence of cookies on your device**

There are different types of cookies that, depending on their characteristics and functions, may persist on your device for different periods of time: so-called session cookies are automatically deleted when you close your browser, while persistent cookies remain on your device for a variable, but pre-determined period of time. In the consent management panel it is indicated the duration of each cookie that we use on this Site.

You may, however, interrupt the persistence period of cookies by deleting them from the cache of your browser.

### **Exercise of rights**

If the necessary prerequisites are met, you will have the right to ask the Data Controller to access, rectify, erase the personal data or restrict the processing of the personal data concerning you, to object to their processing, and to request their portability to transmit them to third parties.
