Important Season Dates

- Practices can start week of: 8/24/2026
- First Weekend of Games: 9/12/2026
- Playoffs start: 10/24/26

Age Verification

Birth Certificates or passports are required for anyone to play!

- If you have played a previous season with us this year and have already submitted you do not need to resubmit!
- We have sent out emails to anyone that still needs to submit!
- The deadline to receive age verification is by **9/11/2026**. If we do not receive a birth certificate or passport the child will not be able to play until we receive it and verify the age. *Please don't wait until the last day!
- What we will take?
 - Birth Certificate
 - Passport
- Parents have these options to submit:

 - Stop by the recreation center for staff to make a copy.

Age Qualification

What is the aging date for this season?

9/1/2026

How does the aging date work?

Whatever age your child was on 9/1/2026 is the division they qualify for.

- Example: My child was 8 on 9/1/2026 They qualify for the 9U division.

Exceptions?

- We only have a few exceptions for someone to be able to play up a division.
 - You can find an informational sheet with more information on exceptions on playtcsports.com!
- We NEVER allow a child to play down and age division due to safety reasons.

Playing Up Requirements

Playing up requirements:

For any child playing up, they have to follow the below requirements:

- Directly requested by the coach
- The parent will be the head coach
- They turn the required age during the season (ex: they are 9 and turn 10 the 2nd week of the season, they can play in 11U)

All players requesting to play up must go through the athletic staff directly PRIOR to registering for the season. They will not be able to register online.

Coaches

We rely on volunteer parent coaches for this league to run! All teams in the league are coached by volunteers!

- **Coach Requirements**
 - **All coaches are required to do a background check in order to coach for the season!**
- **We require each team to have assistant coaches.**
 - **If there is not a cleared assistant available to take over for your team the game will be considered a forfeit.**
- **Anyone who would like to assist on the sideline at games or assist at practice must go through the background check process!**
- **The background check process can take 2-5 business days.**
- **Anyone that is not officially cleared will not be allowed on the sideline.**

Thank you to all of those who have volunteered their time to coach!

Team Formation

Each season is a fresh start for team formation! This means you are not guaranteed to be placed on a team that you have always played with or your friend request! We try our hardest to accommodate all requests that come through, but at a point it becomes impossible when you are trying to accommodate 100-200 requests.

Factors we use to determine teams:

- Number of Players registered
- Number of coaches/teams
- Coach Request
- Friend Requests
- Age
- Seasons Played
- School
- Height
- Weight

*Teams can possibly have a max of 10 on a roster. *10 is not guaranteed

“Why am I not getting the full 10 on my team?”

If we don't receive an equal amount of players per team we won't accommodate the full 10 player requests. We try to even out the teams as best as possible and accommodate as many request possible. As well as to not promote “stacking teams” as the parents refer to it.

If coaches have more than 10 kids requesting to be on their team it is the coach's final decision on who makes it on their team

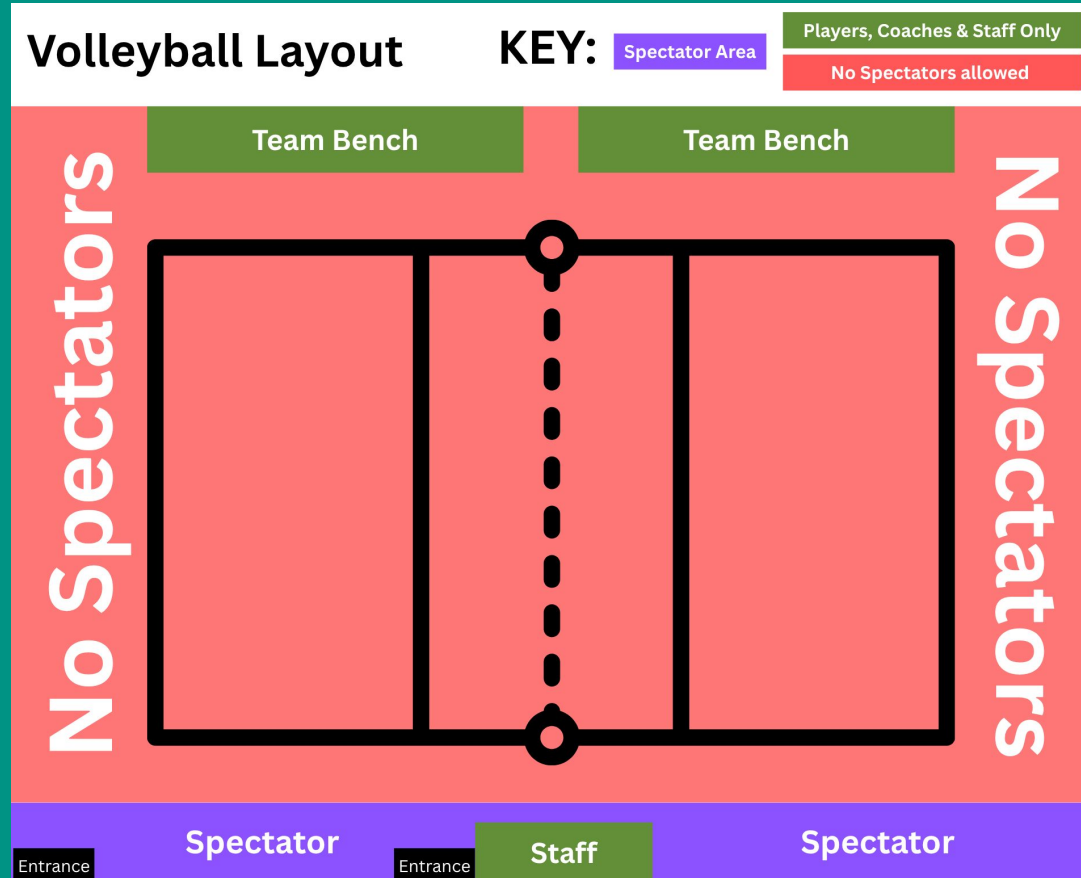
Game Day Information

Spectator Guidelines

All spectators MUST stay in the purple spectator areas noted on the map. Spectators may not come over to the team sidelines, onto the court, or any of the red areas on the map.



Spectator Guidelines

- **Please remember that we are there for the kids to have a fun time learning a sport and playing with their friends!**
- **Any spectator in an unauthorized area will be asked to go back to the spectator zones. If the spectator does not immediately return to the spectator zones they will be asked to leave the facility.**
- **Unsportsmanlike conduct from parents will not be tolerated. Depending on the severity of the conduct we will ask the individual to leave the facility. Play will not resume until they leave.**
- **Ejection/Consequences**
 - **If a parent is ejected from a game they will not be able to attend the next game. Once allowed back if they get ejected for a second time they will not be able to attend any games for the remainder of the season.**
- **The aforementioned suspensions will be the minimum penalty enforced and may be increased in each situation due to the severity of actions.**

Rules – Division Breakdown

- **9U Division**

- **Net Height: 7'0**
- **Ball: Volleylite**
- **Serving Line: 15ft**
- **Middle Back Substitution**

- **11U Division**

- **Net Height: 7'4**
- **Ball: Volleylite**
- **Serving Line: 23ft line**
- **Middle Back Substitution**

- **13U Division**

- **Net Height: 7'4**
- **Ball: Official Size**
- **Serving Line: Backcourt line**
- **Middle Back or 1 for 1 Substitution**

Line Judges

- Each team is responsible for providing a volunteer line judge for the game. If a line judge is not provided by a team the game will be deemed a forfeit.
- Line Judges must be 15 years or older
- Line Judges cannot be a coach from any team. This also means coaches cannot line judge for other teams.
- Line judges will need to stand on the corner of the court.
- Line judges will remain on the same side of the court throughout the entire match
- All calls are ultimately the head officials decision.

Jerseys/Equipment

- Each team will receive a new set of jerseys.
- We will **NOT** have extra jerseys at games so please make sure your child is wearing their jersey or has their jersey for the game.
- Please make sure your players are **ONLY** using the jersey provided for this season.
- **Volleyballs**
 - Provided volleyballs for practice and games. Though we recommend buying your own volleyball to ensure there is not a volleyball shortage at practice.
- **Knee Pads**
 - Not provided, nor required, but **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED**.

 - This will be a site you can go to specifically for your team! It will have roster information, contact information, practice schedules, game schedules, and you will be able to communicate with your team directly from this site!
