

Parents are notified at five unexcused absences and again at 10 unexcused absences. At 10 unexcused absences, a report to the Department of Child Services (DCS) may be mandated, and parents can face legal consequences, including potential prosecution for habitual truancy.

Girls on the Run we inspire girls to recognize their inner strength and celebrate what makes them one of a kind. Trained volunteer coaches use our research-based curricula, running games, and discussions to help girls feel limitless. Over the course of the ten-week program, girls develop essential skills to help them navigate their worlds. Our program culminates with girls positively impacting their communities through a service project and being prepared to complete a celebratory 5K event.

Why It Matters

Girls face social pressures and conflicting messages about how they should act and who they should be. Studies show that during adolescence, girls' confidence drops about twice as much as boys', friendships become more complicated and challenging, girls' perceptions of their academic success declines, their risk for anxiety and depression goes up and their participation in physical activity plummets.


