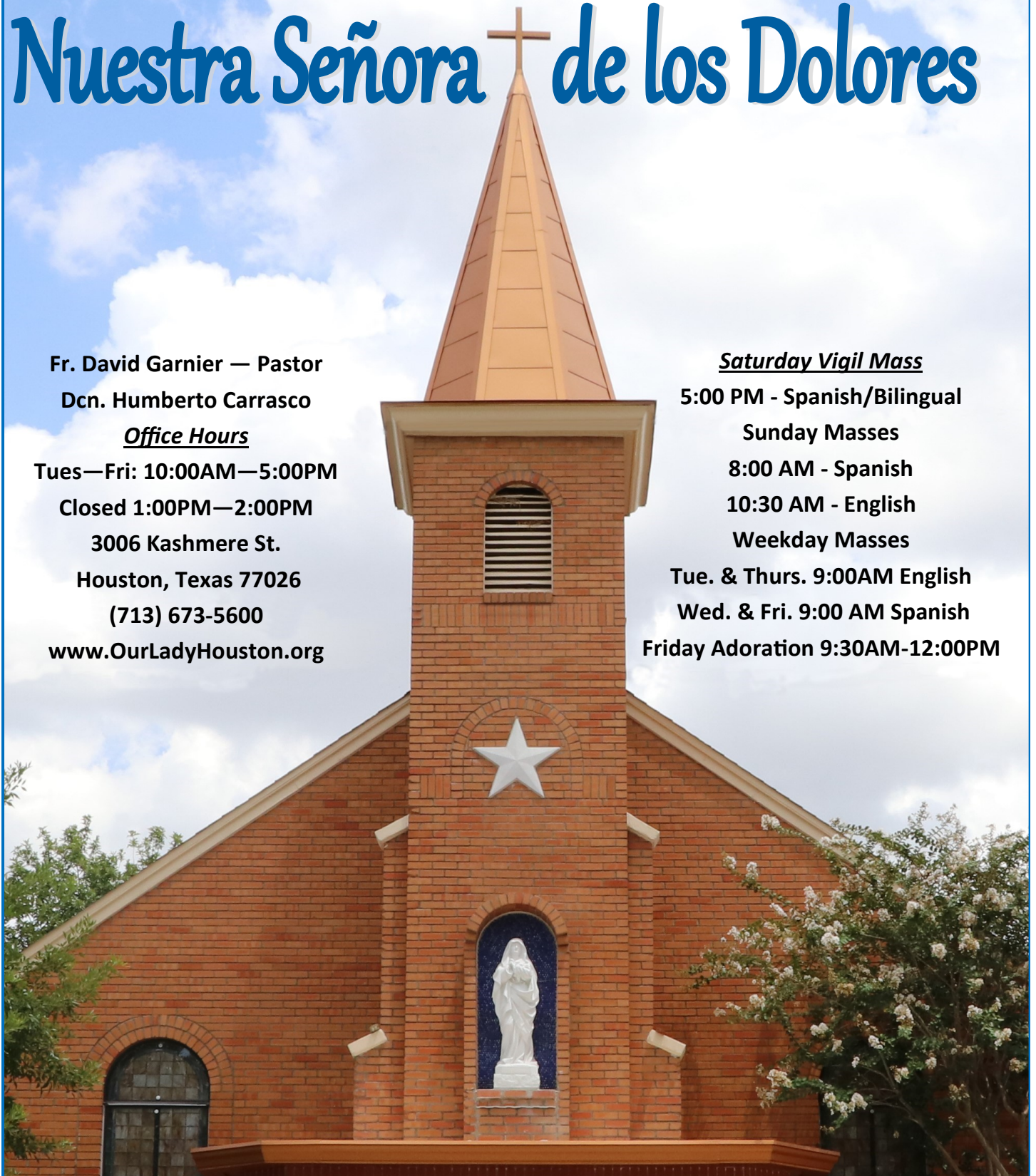

“The Statue of Hospitality”

Approximately twelve score and seven years ago, “our fathers brought forth, upon this continent, a new nation, conceived in liberty, and dedicated to the proposition that all men are created equal,” as Abraham Lincoln once reminded us. This week, we as a nation once again mark that new beginning, we who have inherited its blessings as a gift generously bestowed upon us by those who have gone before us, a gift not deserved but nevertheless ours, a gift we do not own yet pass on to generations to come, a gift we eagerly share.

Hospitality is something to extend to those who come to our doors; it is also something we can extend to those who come to our shores. It seems worthwhile, then, especially this week and amid so many disagreements over immigration, to revisit the words inscribed at the base of the Statue of Liberty, written by the poet Emma Lazarus and etched into our psyche as a nation. These words serve as a vision of who we are, perhaps as much as our Constitution does.

Give me your tired, your poor,
Your huddled masses yearning to breathe free,
The wretched refuse of your teeming shore.
Send these, the homeless, tempest-tost to me;
I lift my lamp beside the golden door!

In today’s reading, the woman at Shunem offered Elisha the prophet hospitality, and she was blessed. Jesus promised that those who offer the hospitality of a cup of cold water will be blessed. Surely, then, any nation that welcomes others in hospitality will be blessed as well.

“La Estatua de la Hospitalidad”

Hace aproximadamente doscientos cuarenta y siete años, “nuestros padres dieron origen en este continente a una nueva nación, concebida en libertad y consagrada al principio de que todos los hombres son creados iguales”, tal como nos recordó una vez Abraham Lincoln. Esta semana, como nación, conmemoramos nuevamente ese nuevo comienzo; nosotros, que hemos heredado sus bendiciones como un regalo generosamente otorgado por quienes nos precedieron: un regalo inmerecido pero que, no obstante, es nuestro; un regalo que no poseemos en propiedad, sino que transmitimos a las generaciones venideras; un regalo que compartimos con entusiasmo.

La hospitalidad es algo que podemos brindar a quienes llegan a nuestras puertas, pero también a quienes arriban a nuestras costas. Resulta oportuno, entonces —especialmente esta semana y en medio de tantas discrepancias sobre la inmigración—, volver a las palabras inscritas en la base de la Estatua de la Libertad, escritas por la poetisa Emma Lazarus y grabadas en nuestra conciencia colectiva como nación. Estas palabras reflejan quiénes somos, tal vez tanto como lo hace nuestra propia Constitución.

Dadme a vuestros cansados, a vuestros pobres,

A vuestras masas hacinadas que anhelan respirar en libertad,

Al desdichado desecho de vuestras costas abarrotadas.

Enviadme a estos, los desamparados, sacudidos por la tempestad;

¡Yo alzo mi antorcha junto a la puerta dorada!
