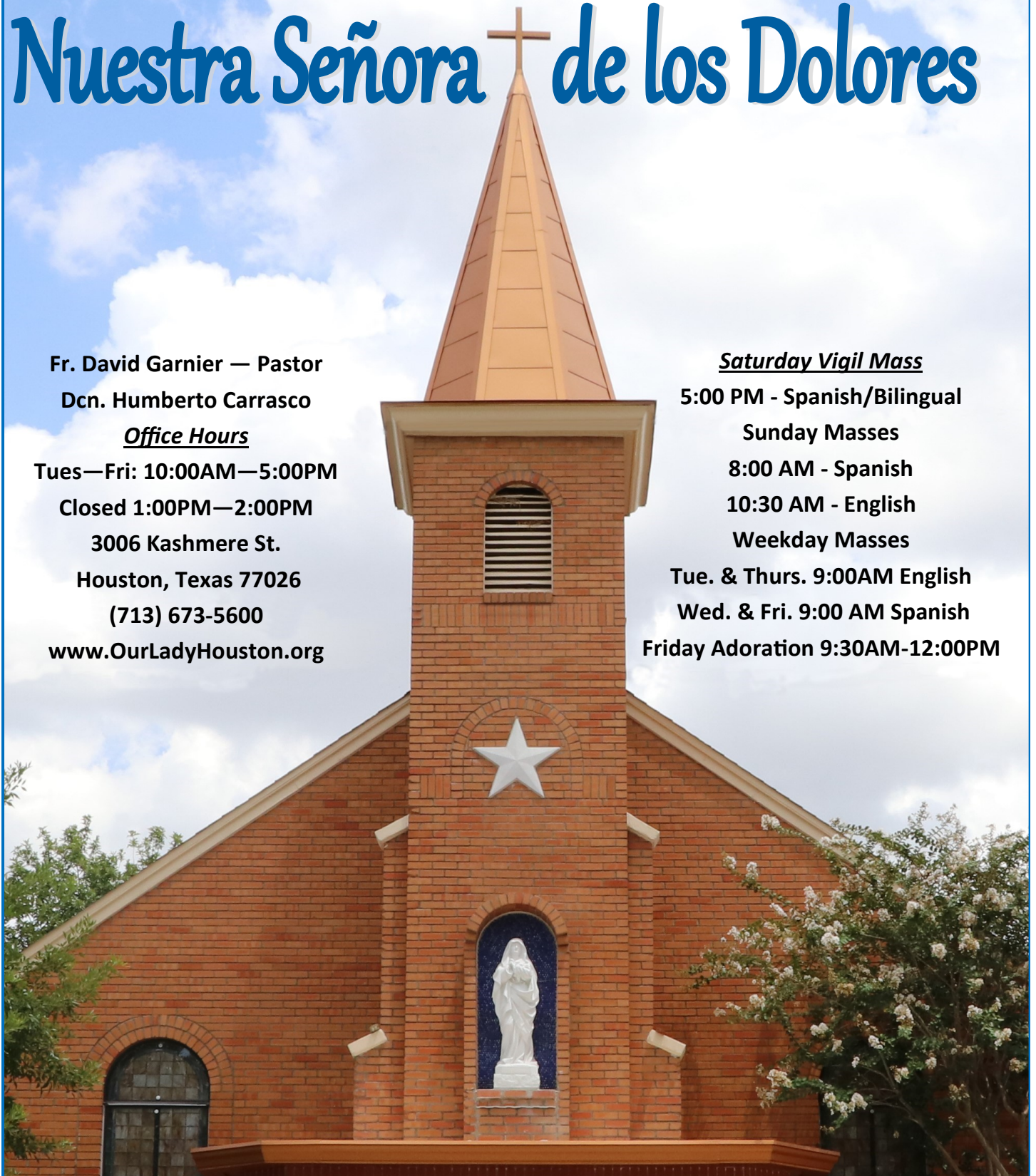

“Fishing for Treasures ”

Much like still-fishing, which is when the fish ultimately find the one sitting quietly, waiting for the fish, most of the really treasured aspects of life somehow find us when we're not looking. Consider falling in love or discovering a friend, the job you enjoy so much that you'd almost do it for free, the hobby that gives you so much satisfaction, the creative gifts you never knew you had until you stumbled upon them later in life. To say nothing of the happiness that so many go looking for and never seem to find, while others are happy without ever seeking it out.

Wisdom, the gift Solomon asked for, is much like all of that. It seems to find us. Common sense, the stepchild of wisdom, is something most parents want their children to have; for some parents, it may be a source of great frustration as they try to make sure their children have it and use it. Wisdom is certainly a hint of the kingdom of heaven, but then so too is finding love and experiencing joy and living with a peace that refuses to be unsettled by the storms of life. All those are the buried treasures of which the gospel speaks; for some, these are the pearl of great price for which they look and look until it finds them, not unlike still-fishing. All are tastes of eternal life, buried treasures, and hidden pearls.

Gospel treasures find us when we're not looking.

“Pescar tesoros”

Al igual que la pesca con caña quieta —esa modalidad en la que los peces terminan encontrando a quien espera pacientemente en silencio—, la mayoría de los aspectos más valiosos de la vida llegan a nosotros cuando menos los buscamos. Pensemos en enamorarse o en descubrir una amistad; en ese trabajo que disfrutas tanto que casi lo harías gratis; en la afición que te brinda tanta satisfacción; o en los dones creativos que no sabías que poseías hasta que diste con ellos más adelante en la vida. Por no hablar de la felicidad que tantos buscan sin éxito, mientras que otros la poseen sin haberla perseguido jamás.

La sabiduría —aquel don que pidió Salomón— es muy parecida a todo esto: parece encontrarnos a nosotros. El sentido común, pariente cercano de la sabiduría, es algo que la mayoría de los padres desean para sus hijos; para algunos, puede ser motivo de gran frustración intentar asegurarse de que sus hijos lo posean y lo apliquen. Sin duda, la sabiduría es un anticipo del Reino de los Cielos, al igual que lo son hallar el amor, experimentar la alegría y vivir con una paz inquebrantable ante las tormentas de la vida. Todas estas cosas son los tesoros escondidos de los que habla el Evangelio; para algunos, representan la perla de gran valor que buscan incansablemente hasta que ella los encuentra a ellos, tal como sucede en la pesca con caña quieta. Todo ello son destellos de vida eterna, tesoros enterrados y perlas ocultas.

Los tesoros del Evangelio nos encuentran cuando no los estamos buscando.
