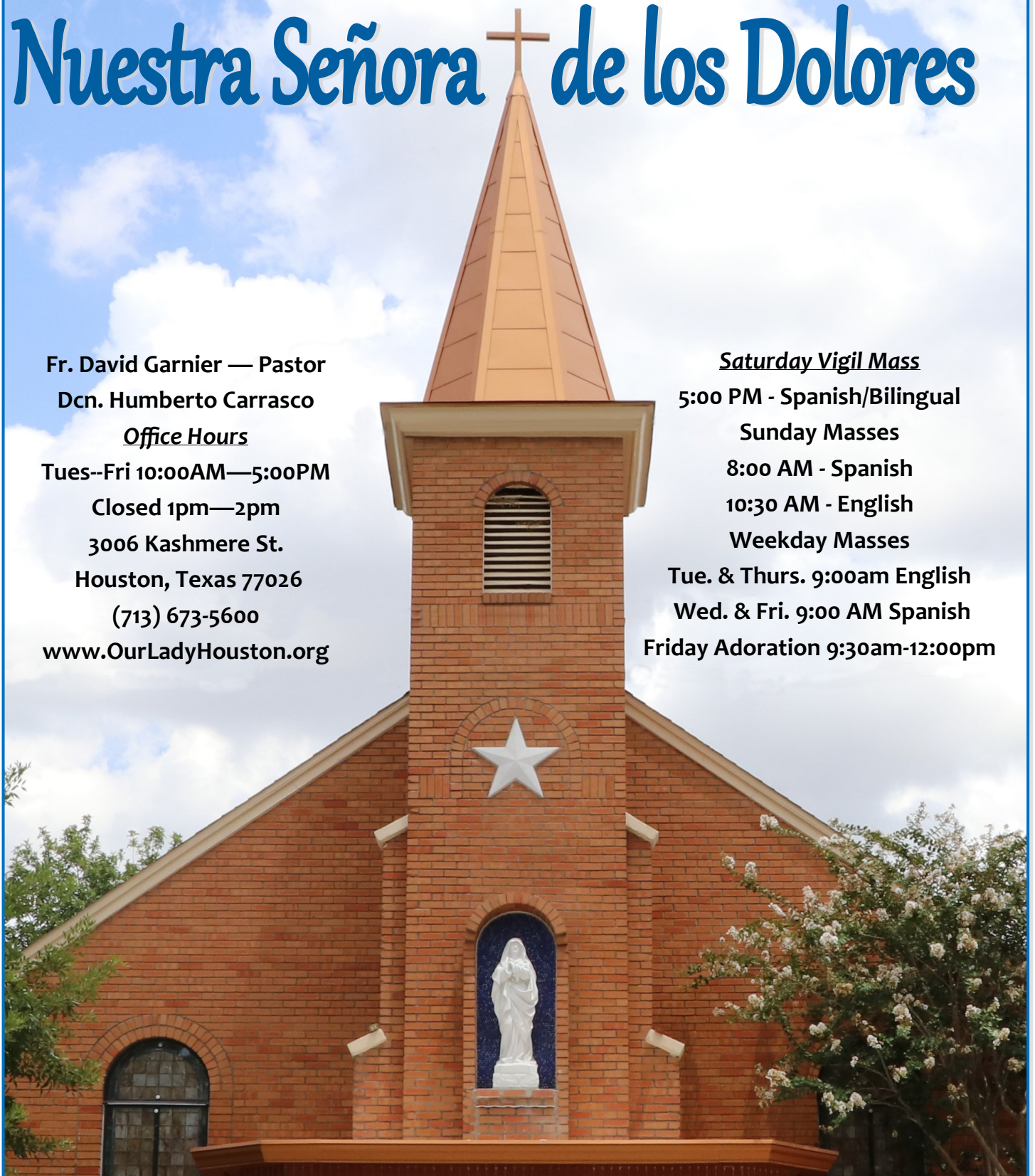

“A Sign of God’s Presence”

Saint John Lateran in Rome was the first Christian basilica, dedicated on November 9 in the year 324. Its name comes from the family who donated the land, the Laterani family, and the church is dedicated under the patronage of both St. John the Baptist and St. John the Evangelist. Until the fourteenth century, the popes lived in the palace adjoining the church, and it—not St. Peter’s—is still the pope’s cathedral. As the pope is the shepherd of the universal Church, the Lateran Basilica of St. John is the cathedral church of the world. Over the doorways of the facade, the inscription reads, *Ecclesiarum Urbis et Orbis Mater et Caput*, that is, “Mother and head of all the churches of the city and of the world.”

The movement of history is to bring people together, not separate them. Witness our technology that has created of our world a global village where we can be in almost instant communication with anyone on the planet. It is through Rome that we connect to all Catholics everywhere. Rome’s failures are our failures. And Rome’s glories are also ours. One of those glories is the freedom to worship as one people despite differences in our native languages, our races, our stations in life. St. Paul writes, “Do you not know that you are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?” (1 Corinthians 3:16). That is what this feast of dedication is about: building the whole people of God, across space and time, into a holy temple.

“Un signo de la presencia de Dios”

San Juan de Letrán en Roma fue la primera basílica cristiana, consagrada el 9 de noviembre del año 324. Su nombre proviene de la familia que donó el terreno, los Laterani, y la iglesia está dedicada bajo la advocación de San Juan Bautista y San Juan Evangelista. Hasta el siglo XIV, los papas residían en el palacio contiguo a la iglesia, y esta —y no la Basílica de San Pedro— sigue siendo la catedral papal. Dado que el papa es el pastor de la Iglesia universal, la Basílica de San Juan de Letrán es la catedral del mundo. Sobre las puertas de la fachada, la inscripción reza: Ecclesiarum Urbis et Orbis Mater et Caput, es decir, “Madre y cabeza de todas las iglesias de la ciudad y del mundo”.

El curso de la historia busca unir a las personas, no separarlas. Contemplemos cómo nuestra tecnología ha creado una aldea global donde podemos comunicarnos casi instantáneamente con cualquier persona en el planeta. Es a través de Roma que nos conectamos con todos los católicos del mundo. Los fracasos de Roma son nuestros fracasos. Y las glorias de Roma también son nuestras. Una de esas glorias es la libertad de adorar como un solo pueblo, a pesar de las diferencias en nuestros idiomas nativos, nuestras razas y nuestras condiciones sociales. San Pablo escribe: «¿Acaso no saben que ustedes son templo de Dios y que el Espíritu de Dios habita en ustedes?» (1 Corintios 3:16). De eso se trata esta fiesta de la dedicación: de edificar a todo el pueblo de Dios, a través del espacio y el tiempo, en un templo santo.

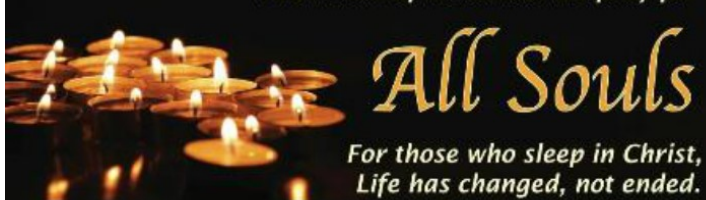
