

Part-Time Youth Development Staff

Youth development staff are responsible for being a positive role model at The Boys & Girls Clubs of Newport County. This Program Staff's primary responsibility is to help oversee a classroom (pod) of members. This individual will report directly to the Director of Childcare and Camp to ensure a positive, supportive and productive environment for all youth.

Job Requirements

- Demonstrated knowledge of principles related to development of youth between 5 and 14 years of age;
- Strong communication skills both oral and written are required;
- Positive role model for members:
- Report properly attired and on time to work;
- Additional training will be provided post-hire;
- According to state law, the Boys & Girls Club must conduct a criminal records check by the Bureau of Criminal Identification of the Department of Attorney General of the State of Rhode Island.
- All staff are expected to assist with our major fundraising events;
- All staff have responsibilities to help fundraise;
- Staff must be flexible as our schedules change to serve our members evening and weekends are expected during the school year.

Job Responsibilities

- Cultivate an environment that is hospitable, safe and welcoming for both members and staff;
- Help provide a fun, safe and educational experience for program participants;
- Oversee a classroom of bilingual members to provide a supportive environment;
- Plan and implement programs on a daily basis, developing curriculum and lesson plans;
- Develop safe and professional relationships between other staff and members;
- Other responsibilities as needed.

Physical Requirements/Work Environment:

Sitting, standing, active up and down within area. Running, bending, swimming, throwing and other childcare related movements.

Terms of Employment:

Part-time, hourly position. Pay range: \$13.00-\$16.00/ hour based on experience and education level.
