Congregational Meeting: We will be having our annual congregational meeting January 25 at 11:15 following fellowship time after church. Worship Insight: “The biblical psalms feature several remarkable expressions of lament. In these laments, the worshiping community expresses grief and frustration at the brokenness of the world, even in situations in which the community is not directly culpable or blameworthy. These biblical laments witness to God’s desire for honesty in worship. No experience in life is too difficult to be brought before God. A lament is an implicit act of faith in which the community of faith turns to God as its only source of hope and comfort.” p111 *The Worship Sourcebook*

There will be a light meal and Bible Study after the evening service. We will be studying Acts 8:1-25 (Lesson 12). Everyone is encouraged to come, even if you didn't start this study with us.
