

FROM THE OFFICE OF THE BISHOP

On February 25th, the Honorable
Wendy Kinsella, Chief U.S.
Bankruptcy Judge for the Northern
District of New York, approved the
Final Decree closing the Chapter 11 reorganization
case for the Roman Catholic Diocese of Syracuse.
This ruling marks the official conclusion of a process
that began on June 19, 2020, aimed at providing
reparation and compensation to survivors of sexual
abuse. Thanks be to God!



Baptism

Anointing of the Sick

The sacrament of strength and healing is available upon request for those who are sick or elderly. Please do not wait too long to call the office for assistance. Please do not wait until your loved one is near death. You can also request the sacrament at area hospitals.

Marriage

Couples should contact the Office to make an appointment with the Parish Life Director to begin their preparation for marriage. Marriages should be scheduled at least six months before the anticipated wedding date.

Illness

Due to HIPPA privacy laws the parish is not notified when parishioners are hospitalized. We ask you contact the parish office when a loved one is hospitalized.

Bereavement

We would like to help you with your needs at your time of loss. Please contact the office for assistance.

LENTEN REGULATIONS

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence.

Catholics, ages 18-59, are bound to the law of fasting.

Catholics 14 years of age and older are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.

It is the obligation of all Catholics, if aware, of serious sin, to approach the sacrament of Reconciliation at least once a year, if possible, during the Easter season.
