We are in need of collection counters after mass on Sundays. We follow a rotating schedule. If you can help, please contact Chris Barnes or the parish office.

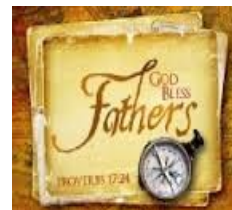


250th Anniversary Parade
