
"Beautiful Eucharist"



In this celebration, hosts which have been previously consecrated by a priest at a mass are distributed for Holy Communion. It is the Real Presence of Jesus that is received in Holy Communion.

Marriages should be scheduled at least six months before the anticipated wedding date.


Illness
