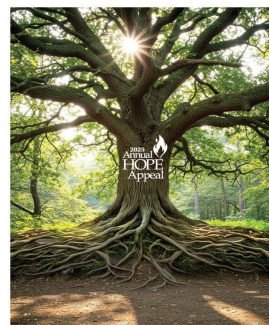

Baptism

Marriage

Couples should contact the Office to make an appointment with the Parish Life Director to begin their preparation for marriage.

Marriages should be scheduled at least six months before the anticipated wedding date.
