
DISCIPLE MAKER INDEX (DMI) SURVEY

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. Catholics, ages 18-59, are bound to the law of fasting.



Catholics 14 years of age and older are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.

It is the obligation of all Catholics, if aware, of serious sin, to approach the sacrament of Reconciliation at least once a year, if possible, during the Easter season.
