REVERENCE FOR BLESSED PALMS

Because the palms are blessed, they are now sacramentals, which "are sacred signs instituted by the Church. They prepare us to receive the fruit of the sacraments and sanctify different circumstances of life" (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1667). Sacramentals should be treated with respect and never be thrown away. Palms may only be burned or buried.

LENTEN REGULATIONS

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. Catholics, ages 18-59, are bound to the law of fasting. Catholics 14 years of age and older are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent. It is the obligation of all Catholics, if aware, of serious sin, to approach the sacrament of Reconciliation at least once a year, if possible, during the Easter season.
