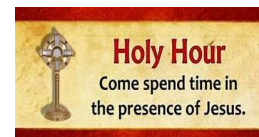
FLOWERS BLOOMING

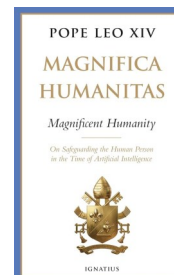
