All Commentators, Greeters, Ushers,

Homebound Ministry need to be
Safe Environment certified.



All liturgical ministers are required to have already
completed the required Safe Environment training and
criminal background check in accordance with
their previously established deadlines:

- Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion
- Music Ministry (Cantors, Choir Members, and Instrumental Members)
 - Sacristans
 - Adult Altar Servers
 - Liturgical Ministry Leaders
 - Lectors/Readers

Any current liturgical ministers who have not completed these requirements by September 30, 2026, will need to temporarily step aside from their ministry until they are in compliance, in keeping with Bishop Lucia's directive and diocesan policy.
