### A Reflection from Megan Condry

*And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of his Spirit who lives in you. Romans 8:11*

This verse came up on a podcast recently and I haven't stopped thinking about it since. Read it again! The same Spirit who raised Jesus from the dead lives in you! It's wild, astounding, beautiful, and generous. And yet, I venture to guess we spend a lot more of our days forgetting this truth than living out of it. What might God do in and through us if we lived out of the power of the Holy Spirit that is in us?

The kids have been obsessed with the David movie! It's the main thing they have talked about for the last month at every opportunity they get! On Sunday mornings and any other gathering we have, they are talking about David. All with big smiles on their faces sharing how much they love the soundtrack and retelling details from the movie. They are captivated by David's story. How he trusted God and how he continued to seek God through all the twists and turns of his life. I think they are truly captivated by seeing God at work. At Kids' Growing with Jesus they were dancing and singing along to "Follow the Light" with one little guy doing the voices and sound effects from the movie too! Their enthusiasm and love for all things David is incredible.

While seeing the movie at the theater, I encountered God at work by the way he touched my heart through the story of David. I found myself getting emotional a time or two. But what got me the most was seeing the kids watch the movie. One girl was standing up for most of the movie, fully engaged, and talking to David. "Oh no! Be careful, David! Watch out!" One of the older girls said that she started crying at a particular scene. Others shared details from David's story that surprised them and where they saw God's faithfulness and power! They all had a new hunger to learn more about David's story and God's story. Including me! I want to read God's Word and soak up all the details of David's life and I'm pretty sure the kids do too!

As we look ahead to Lent, I'm thinking a lot about the enthusiasm of the kids to talk about the David movie, to listen to the songs on repeat, and to keep learning more about our amazing God. I'm also really captivated by the truth that the same Spirit that raised Jesus from the dead lives in us. Lent is a unique season. It's an opportunity to experience and encounter Jesus more intentionally. We'll be sharing some different ways you engage in the Lenten season with our St. Pete's community. I encourage you to invite God into this season. It doesn't need to be complicated or look a certain way. Just make yourself available and watch God move. I invite you to listen to the David soundtrack. It will be 30 minutes well spent. You'll be encouraged and might just find yourself singing along! Reflect over the next few months on the reality that the Holy Spirit lives in you. May you be challenged and encouraged as I was by these words from Chris Tiegreen.

"And, as with everything else of lasting significance, there's only one way to receive his power; by being in his presence. We aren't empowered by the Holy Spirit by default; we have to be in relationship and conversation with God and available for his purposes; just as the first believers were on the Day of Pentecost. When we do - and when we cultivate the kind of relationship that makes us aware of and receptive to his power - things happen."
