

SIGNS OF THE TIMES **DANNY EMERSON**

As Jesus sat up on the mount of Ol-

ives, the disciples came to Jesus privately, because they wanted to know. What would be the signs of Jesus coming? And what would be the signs of the end of the world?

In Matthew 24, Jesus gave them some of the signs to look for, so they would know His coming was near.

He told them of, "wars and rumours of wars," and He said that "nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places."

He also told them "because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold."

In October 2022, there were 3145 earthquakes within 30 days.

About a week ago, I looked the same stats, and I found that in the past 30 days, there have been 52,451 quakes (with magnitudes up to 8.8).

These earthquakes have been in diverse places, just as Jesus predicted.

The news is filled with wars continually—and talk of more. Ukraine, Russia, Israel, Palestine, Iran, and even the U.S. are all in the headlines.

Some of the events Jesus foretold are happening right before our eyes.

I truly believe we are living in the end time.

Other things are taking place today, that the Bible foretold.

- 2 Timothy 3:1 This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.
- 2 For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,
- 3 Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good,
- 4 Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God;
- 5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.

We can see these traits in a greater measure than we have ever seen them before.

Not long ago, we experienced something most of us had never experienced—when we were plagued by COVID-19.

COVID-19 has officially claimed 5 million lives, but credible estimates place the pandemic's true death toll closer to 17 million. Either count secures COVID-19's position on our list of history's deadliest plagues. Again, Jesus told us "pestilences" are one of the signs of His coming and of the end of the world.

The Good News is-in the midst of all the turmoil of this old world...

...But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound:

Is there Hope for me???

If you are a child of God, the grace of God is enough to keep and protect you...

No matter what comes against you!

When we see the signs of the times, it's so important to put our trust in the Lord.

It's so important to make sure we are right with God! It's so important to know you are a child of God filled with The Holy Ghost!

The Holy Ghost will guide you in all truth. (See Jn 16:13).

OUR BIBLE COURSE Patrick Hayes

In the mid-1970's, Brother Hall asked three of us younger ministers to put together a Bible correspondence course for UCCMA. It was not to be a systematic theology or a doctrinaire catechism arguing for any Christian creed against another. I can still hear him.

"Leave all of that out of it. No opinions about embracing or rejecting any group's viewpoints. It has to be something that anyone can learn the Bible from, without sectarian bias. Baptist, Methodist, Catholic, Mormon, Adventist, Calvinist, Anglican, Pentecostal, Charismatic— none of that stuff one way or the other. Understand? No one-God, two-God, three-God ideas. And no end-time theories. Don't try to interpret Isaiah, for instance, or Revelations. Just teach what the Bible says, that's all. All, nothing more. Let people learn the Bible first, and make-up their own minds."

"But what if they draw wrong conclusions?" I asked.

"And what if you've drawn wrong conclusions, Pat? What if I have? What if we all have, all of us? All the way down through the ages, people have fussed and quarreled. You can't stop that. The thing is, most of them have never even read the whole Bible on their own without someone else's voice in their heads telling them what to think about this-that-or-the-other. Not even our own preachers, many of them, know the whole Bible. And just the Bible, and only the Bible. See?"

We nodded at him. "Yes, sir." But he knew that we did not yet know what a challenge it would be. It sounded simple.

"Just start with the first 'In the beginning' of Genesis. Have the student read the chapter and answer questions about what it says. Not what you or the student might think it means. Leave your opinions out of it. Only what the Scripture says, period. Hard to do, you can't imagine, because you're preachers. But do it that way. Then do that for every chapter and book of the Bible, all the way through to the last 'Amen' of Revelations."

Well, we went to work and got it done. It took us a few years. I worked on the narrative books of the Old Testament. Kent worked on the Gospels. Mike focused on the prophetic and poetic books and the Epistles. We were young, but learning. The hardest demand, that we must not comment or preach... well, we failed in that. I look over the Bible Course today and see again and again our insertions of doctrinal biases. But

mostly we tried to follow Brother Hall's directive, to present a study guide for thorough Bible reading and contemplation.

I am known today by some as a Bible teacher. People ask me how I "know it so well." They don't know how much I am still learning about it. I do not belong to any "ism" or claim any doctrinal bias. That's Brother Hall, still speaking to me. Whatever gifting I might have has come to me from his assignment to write a study course about the Bible and only the Bible.

We call it GENERAL BIBLE KNOWLEDGE. A student must complete the Old Testament lessons before beginning the New Testament. We offer diplomas for completions, and cap-and-gown graduations.

But these things might sometimes be detrimental to Brother Hall's main idea. "It's not how much you've learned, to hang on the wall; it's how much the Bible opens before you that you yet have to learn in life. Even if you memorize the whole Thing, you still have to live it out to really know it. And that's where the Holy Ghost comes in, to make the Word alive in you."

We at UCCMA would love for you to take this Bible course. It is not very expensive. It will draw you in. You will find yourself pondering the Bible's immensities and its profundities, and opening "the Great Conversation" about God and Christ with people all around you. It will benefit and change their lives as it has yours. Let's get away from the thematic doctrines of TV preaching personalities, and just get into the Scriptures for ourselves. You'll be amazed at what the Spirit of God Alone will teach you.

THE BEAUTY OF HOLINESS PASTOR MARK MEEKER

The Spirit of the Lord spoke to me the first of

the year: "Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God" (2 Cor. 7:1).

You may not know me. Who I am is not as important as "Whose I am." My wife, Tressie, and I pastor a little Holiness Church in Boone County, WV, the hometown of the J.O. (Jake) Townley family. I can take you right to the property, less than five minutes from our church, where Brother Townley lived.

It was so wonderful when we made the connection of how God brings life in a circle. Some of the older Townley girls were baptized in our little church when it was First Baptist. I consider Sister Paulette Hilton, Brother Don Warren, and Sister Lucille Hall some of my dearest friends. Brother Hall was nice enough to recognize me in the meetings and let me sing a time or two, but he was Brother Hall, so you took that for love. My proudest memory with Brother Don is that he said my organ and Leslie cabinet were the best combination he had ever played. "They're just so in sync with each other," he said, a comment that made me proud considering he had played thousands of organs.

My, what promises God has given! Paul was exhorting the Corinthians to cleanse themselves in the flesh and spirit. "Perfecting holiness in the fear of God." The Lord spoke to me and said, "While you are perfecting holiness, PRESERVE holiness."

I started thinking about my flesh and spirit. We know our flesh gets out of line, but have you ever had your spirit to get out of line? Not God's Spirit, it is always in order but what about ours? Remember this verse? "Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God" (1 Jn 4:1). We must keep our spirit right and in tune with His Spirit.

We can lead people astray if our spirit gets out of order. Have you ever said or heard someone say, "I have a bad spirit?" I have. We need to regularly check ourselves. Make sure we are always "walking in the spirit."

My next thought is on holiness—perfecting and preserving it as the scripture instructs. It is up to us to do both. I often weep at what our young generation is missing. The holiness of the churches in where we started. My daddy started out as an old time Freewill Baptist minister, and he received the Holy Ghost in a little Church of God in the Route 44 area where Brother Hall ministered so often. Both of my great Grannies were little Holiness ladies, one of them was a Church of God minister in the 40s and 50s. My first real experience was in a little Holiness church in Salem, VA. Pot belly stove, outside bathrooms with a path, hardwood floors worn out from shouting and an old upright piano with a straight back chair and a few flattop guitars. My, was the glory there—the very Holiness that Isaiah saw, "high and lifted up." No form, no fashion just a total atmosphere for the worship of a Holy GOD! The music wasn't professional, the singers weren't trained, and the dance was definitely not rehearsed! They told me it was the "Holy Dance." I was hooked! I wanted it all. The holiness, the worship, the presence of Almighty God flowing freely. I even saw a little sister playing a set of kitchen spoons under the anointing of the Holy Ghost.

That little church was packed wall to wall, everyone "got in", they

worshiped, danced, shouted, praised, testified, preached and had a "healing line." It was all in order, it was all God, and it was ALL this 12-year-old boy needed to be hooked on the "Beauty of Holiness!"

Within weeks I was washing dishes at my little Baptist grandma's house and right there with my hands in a pan of dishwater the sweet Holy Ghost washed me!! My heart, My soul! He sanctified me in His Holiness and filled me with His wonderful Holy Ghost. I saw Mamaw get a glimpse out of the corner of my eye, and she just went on about her business.

She knew what was going on. I'm still blessed to have her today, she is 97 years old, still blessed to live in her own home and she is one of my biggest supporters, my prayer warrior, my little sanctified Baptist grandma.
