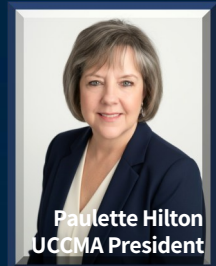


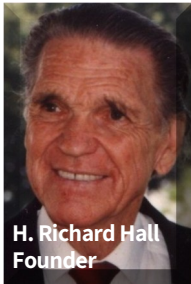

LOOK ONLY TO HIM!

“Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the Lord is risen upon thee. For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the Lord shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee” (Is. 60:1-2).

A greater event than that of Pentecost is at hand! The Upper Room outpouring of the Spirit delivered and set apart the true Church from the sectarian synagogue system of that day. One hundred and twenty people upset the Pharisee and Sadducee system by Divine appointment and ordination. They were God-empowered, Holy Ghost-filled, and Jesus-anointed to turn the religious world upside down.

They were in unity, in one accord, looking to one High Priest—Christ Jesus, the Lord. They were not received, nor ordained, nor approved by the Church system of that day.

God-ordained, anointed and chosen; Holy Ghost-baptized, filled and thrilled, washed in the Blood of the Lamb, without blemish; They

healed the sick and afflicted. They raised the dead with their anointing of Resurrection Life.

They cast out devils and demons. They set free those who were oppressed. They asked for nothing from the church system of that day. They desired to do and did only those things commanded of them by the “Beloved Master, the Lord Jesus Christ.”

They obeyed the call to “Go into all the world and preach the Gospel (not system or manmade doctrine or creed) to every creature.” No space limits—go to ALL the world. Preach the Gospel! What gospel? The Gospel of Christ—none other—“to every creature.” No race limits—to all races: white, black, brown or red. To the Jew, Greek and Gentile. To the rich, poor, bond and free. Preach to every man, woman, and child everywhere.

Jesus gave no heed to the plans, ideas, and ways of the synagogue (church) system when He was upon the earth. He did the work of that God who sent Him.

The End-time Ministry gives no heed to condemnation, criticism

or ostracism of the religionists of this day. He is ordained, called, and appointed for this hour of destiny. He will not be stopped! The End-Time minister, prophet, or apostle has been brought forth, raised up, called out, ordained, blessed, and predestined to speak with Divine Unction, to prophesy with divine authority, and to take action against satanic forces. The Last Days prophets will obey only the voice of Him who sends them.

“And now abideth faith, hope charity, these three: but the greatest of these is charity (love)” (1 Corinthians 13:13).

The Bible is one great, overarching story of God’s unending love for us. It is the story of humanity—created and deeply loved by God—and our continuous rebellion against Him.

It would be a terrible tragedy if the story ended there! But what the Bible says in essence about love is this: God is love. God loves you. And He came to earth and sacrificed everything—even His life—to rescue you.

God’s love is so much greater than any earthly words can articulate. When we talk about what love is in the Bible, we speak of a love that is beyond our understanding. However, the Bible teaches us about love in a few key ways.

“By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another” (Jn.13:35). Each Bible verse on love gives us insight into God’s love for us and how He wants us to relate to each other.

Everyone we meet is someone God loves. If we are ever tempted to hate someone, we need to remember there is a 100% chance that God loves them unconditionally! As we remember this in our daily lives, it will help us to see others as God sees them. It will lead us to love others. We are called to be conduits of God’s love to those around us.

It’s not always easy! But it is impossible to love God and not, in turn, love others. Trust the Holy Spirit to help God’s love flow through you to those around you.

How many times is the meaning of love in the Bible. We need to love people—not their sins. We can be nice to people and still show them we care for their souls. Jesus left the ninety-nine and went after that one lost sheep. Let us redeem the time, for the Lord Jesus Christ is coming soon.

Many people do not believe Jesus is coming back to this earth again. You need to get in your Bible and read the truth about what it says—not just listen to others.

“Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye. And above all these things put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness” (Col. 3:13-14).

These Bible verses teach us that the law can be summed up in one word: Love. Love is the very heart of God, and love is at the heart of God’s law for us. We can fulfill God’s commandments through loving Him and loving our neighbor.

The Bible says love is a selfless and sacrificial devotion that prioritizes the good of the other person, while lust is a selfish desire for pleasure that objectifies and uses others for one’s own gratification. Love is described as patient, kind, and enduring—as exemplified by Christ’s love for the Church (see Ephesians 5:25). In contrast, lust is fleeting, rooted in the flesh, and can lead to sin and shame.

We can try to muscle our way through, go through the motions, or follow God’s law. But, as it says in Matthew 22, “Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind . . . Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.” If there’s no love, everything we try to do through our own strength will fall. Love must be the source and center of everything we do.

REMEMBER THE CROSS

FROM THE LATE DON WARREN ARCHIVES



One passage in particular draws me back over and over. I know you are very familiar with the passage, but I must obey the Lord and share it here on these pages. It is the fourth chapter of 2nd Corinthians:

“Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not; But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man’s conscience in the sight of God. But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them. For we preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord; and ourselves your servants for Jesus’ sake. For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us. We are troubled on every side, yet not distressed; we are perplexed, but not in despair; Persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed; Always bearing about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our body. For we

which live are always delivered unto death for Jesus’ sake, that the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our mortal flesh. So then death worketh in us, but life in you. We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak; Knowing that he which raised up the Lord Jesus shall raise up us also by Jesus, and shall present us with you. For all things are for your sakes, that the abundant grace might through the thanksgiving of many redound to the glory of God. For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward man is renewed day by day. For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory; While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal.”

The gospel of Jesus Christ is true, and it is powerful. I am not necessary for the gospel to go forth. But, by the grace of God, He has let me be a part of His ministry almost my whole life. I can honestly say the drawing, convicting power of Jesus is what our pastors, evangelists, missionaries,—every minister—needs today.

Cunning words, sad tear-drenched stories may get our loved

ones to the altar. But the power of Jesus Christ is what saves from sin.

It’s what takes a hardened heart—hardened by the deceitfulness of sin—and makes it new.

As the UCCMA revival team travels every week to an area near you to share the precious gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ, I pray you will come and bring the lost, bring the hurting, and those in despair. Plead with the ones who need a Savior, just as I’m pleading with you now.

Where would I be without the Lord? Just like you, my friend, I haven’t lived a perfect life. There were times I was afraid to be near Grandma Woodyard—afraid the Lord would share my faults and shortcomings with her. But the Cross of Christ was always there pulling me near—drawing me close again.

Never give up! Never give up on the call God has placed in your life. Never give up on the salvation of your family. Even if you feel there’s no way to turn, nowhere to go that won’t make you look like a failure—just remember, the Cross of Calvary is still drawing you. The blood of Jesus is still available to you.

What would you gain to have the respect and honor of earthly men and lose your soul? I’ve always heard, “Be sure, your sins will find you out.” How very true that is.

YOU ARE THE TEMPLE OF GOD!

In the Old Testament, there was an item that God had instructed Moses to have built. It was called “The Ark of The Covenant.”

The ark was created according to the pattern given to Moses by God. It was a chest made of acacia wood, and covered in solid gold. It had an ornamental lid – called “The Mercy Seat.”

The Ark was representative of the presence of God, for as the Bible said: “... the LORD of hosts that dwelleth between the cherubims” (2 Sam. 6:2).

God met with Moses and communed with him “from between the two cherubims which are upon the ark of the testimony” (Ex. 25:22).

Hebrews 9:4 tells us the Ark contained:

- The golden pot that contained manna,
- Aaron’s rod that budded,
- The tables of the covenant (10 commandments).

David eventually brought the Ark of the Covenant into Jerusalem.

“... So David went and brought up the ark of God from the house of

Obededom into the city of David with gladness. And David danced before the LORD with all his might; and David was girded with a linen ephod. So David and all the house of Israel brought up the ark of the LORD with shouting, and with the sound of the trumpet” (2 Sam. 6:12-15).

TODAY—We should REALLY be Rejoicing!

In The Old Testament, they had that ark that they carried around;

But today, We don’t have to carry around a wooden box—God has chosen to dwell WITHIN US!

NOW – WE are The ARK of His Covenant!

“Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?” (1 Cor. 3:16).

“What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?” (1 Cor. 6:19).

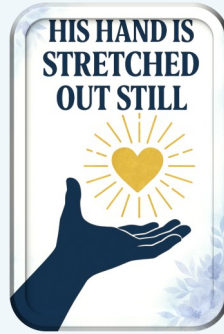
ONE SOUL! ONE MOMENT! ONE ETERNITY!

This generation stands at the same place where the disciples stood when they received the baptism of the Holy Ghost. Therefore, we must go forth with the same goal and the same mission. We must be led by the Spirit of God—without question—into the battlefield of Satan. The fullness of the Gospel must be preached into all the world!

LICENSE VS. ORDINATION

A BRIEF SYNOPSIS OF LICENSURE CONFERRED BY UCCMA

The **LICENSE (Certificate of Ministry)** grants the right to PREACH AND TEACH only. Those who hold the this license cannot perform weddings, communions, baptisms, etc. This license is issued to ministers who are just getting started in their ministry and to those who work in hospitals, convalescent homes, do personal witnessing, serve as youth pastors, etc. It is our policy that all who receive a minister's license work under a senior pastor for at least a year before applying for the Ministerial Ordination (receiving a recommendation from him/her.)

The **ORDINATION LICENSE (Ministerial Ordination)** grants the full privileges of the ministry. This

Ministerial Ordination is given to those who are in full-time evangelism, pastoral work, chaplaincy, etc. **ALL MINISTERS WHO GIVE PERSONAL COUNSELLING NEED TO BE SURE IT IS LEGAL IN YOUR STATE.** Some states require a special Counselors' License before a minister can serve in this capacity. **ALL WHO HOLD THE ORDINATION LICENSE** must check with their local courthouse to determine whether their license must to be registered in their state in order for you to give this service. (As stated in our bylaws, UCCMA ordained ministers unequivocally affirm that marriage is a covenant relationship between a man and a woman and reject all attempts to redefine marriage in terms of same-sex unions and behavior.)

Many states have laws concerning ministry and ordination within their jurisdiction. We cannot determine the requirements you must meet in your state of residence. We strongly advise that, **before** performing any weddings, baptisms, funerals, communions, etc., you inquire at the courthouse in the county where the ceremony will take place to ensure you have met all local requirements.

UCCMA MISSIONS IN AFRICA

TYLER RAMSEY

Many UCCMA associate ministers have taken-on a particular burden for Africa, and have traveled there to preach the basic Gospel. One of our group, John Tyler Ramsey, goes repeatedly on-his-own-wallet to preach in several African nations, including Uganda, Gambia, and South Africa. —Patrick Hayes, UCCMA World Missions Director.

This month in Uganda, we witnessed the power of the Gospel in a way that will echo for generations. A church was dedicated, pastors were ordained and equipped, and multitudes found salvation. Yet among all the miracles, the most profound moment was not in the number of salvations, the ordinations, or even the



celebrations—it was in the unveiling of the Father’s heart to a people who had only known Him as a task-master.

For years, many in this region were taught that their relationship with God depended on merit. Every blessing hinged on the haunting question: Am I good enough? Am I doing enough? God was portrayed as a stern overseer, holding a ledger of failures. The Holy Ghost, though honored, was often presented only as an emotional experience—a moment of shouting, speaking in tongues, or feeling goosebumps—rather than the Comforter, Teacher, and Empowering Presence Jesus promised.

But when the Word of God was opened, a new light began to shine. The revelation was simple yet life-changing: God is not merely a Master to be served, but a Father who welcomes sons and daughters.

Jesus Himself declared, “I no longer call you servants... Instead, I have called you friends” (John 15:15). Even more, Paul wrote in Romans 8:15, “You did not

receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, ‘Abba, Father!’” This truth breaks chains. It shifts identity from laboring servants to beloved children.

When people saw the difference between being a servant and being a son, their faces changed. A servant works for wages, hoping to be accepted. A son already belongs. A servant fears rejection if the task is not done well. A son knows his place at the table is secure. A servant has access only to assignments. A son has access to inheritance.

This message ignited hope. For the first time, many realized that salvation is not a finish line of endless striving but the starting line of relationship. To be a son or daughter of God is to walk in the assurance that He delights in you—not because of what you do, but because of who you are in Christ.

In Uganda, we saw the weight lift off shoulders as men and women embraced their new identity. Tears flowed, voices lifted, and pastors themselves were refreshed with this liberating truth. They discovered that God’s greatest desire is not to make workers but to raise children who reflect His image and carry His authority.

As the church was dedicated, pastors ordained, and people saved, the true dedication was deeper: lives dedicated to the Father who calls His people sons and daughters. This revelation will not only transform individuals but reshape churches, families, and communities across Uganda and beyond.

For when God is known as Father, faith is no longer fear-driven—it is love-driven. And love, unlike fear, never fails.

WINNING OVER FEAR

Have you ever been afraid? Of course you have! Everyone

has experienced fear at one time or another. But, the important question is this—Does fear have a grip on your life? Are there times when you find yourself bound by fear, with what seems no way to escape? If so, there is good news for you!

“For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind” (2 Timothy 1:7). You can live in the peace of God today! Here’s how.

1). Remember who you are: The apostle Paul is not writing to those who are “lost” but, rather to those who are saved. Are you a child of God? If so, remind yourself of who you are. God has many blessings and provisions for His children, but fear is not one of them.

2). Rejoice with praise to the Lord: To love the Lord is to praise Him. Praise will always cause walls to fall. King Jehoshaphat had plenty of reason to fear. However, in obedience to the word of the Lord, he began to offer praise to God. When He did, the battle was won. Satan can’t defeat a “praising Christian”!

3). Rest in the peace of God:

As you look back at King Jehoshaphat, you find that because the people obeyed the Lord, God fought their battle for them. The result was “Peace and rest” (2 Chronicles 20:30).

Philippians 4:7 tells us “. . . the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.”

Don’t allow your fears to hinder your walk with God and limit your effectiveness. Walk in the peace of God and win over fear! Let the power of God silence every fear.

Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God: And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world” (1 John 4:1-3).

So, who is on the Lord’s side?

Now is the time to look to Jesus—honor that name, lift Him above all names. For He is the one who died for our sins to redeem us by His precious blood.

We must tell the world about Jesus.

“Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God? This is he that came by water and blood, even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit that beareth witness, because

the Spirit is truth. For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one. And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one” (5:5-8).

Jesus was conceived of the Holy Ghost. He was anointed of the Holy Ghost. On the cross, He gave up the Ghost. At the cross, He gave His life that we might have life more abundantly.

He gave Himself to us. When He ascended into heaven, He gave the promise. While on earth, He had the Holy Ghost—the Holy Ghost had Him.

He promised that Holy Ghost to those He sent to Jerusalem to tarry.

“... It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you” (Jn 16:7). This means the Comforter was with Him.

He released the Holy Ghost when He ascended to heaven—there it was!

As a rushing mighty wind—it sat upon the ones who had tarried for it 120 days.

“And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions: And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my spirit” (Joel 2:28, 29).

God is preparing a great army to preach the gospel to all nations, races, and creeds. They are warning the people to flee the wrath of God to come.

Even as Noah warned the people when the world was going to be destroyed by water and only eight souls were saved, now God is calling to His own to come into the ark of safety—away from the wickedness of this world. That ark, my friend, is Jesus—the light of the world.

These, His people, are to be a holy nation, a royal priesthood, a peculiar people—a people of one mind and one accord. There will be a new heaven and a new earth wherein dwelleth righteousness.

before the morning of time.

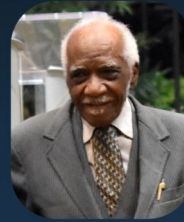

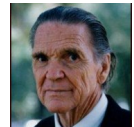

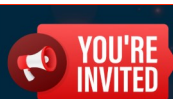
