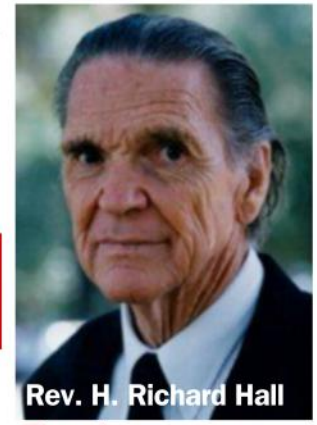

COME DRAW FROM THE WELL!

There's a stirring in Cleveland as we move toward convention. It isn't a shallow excitement or eager anticipation—it's a deep, spiritual hunger for more of God.

When men and women filled with the Holy Ghost gather with purpose, we can expect powerful things to unfold in the Name of Jesus. I am reminded of something Brother Don once said, and it resonates in my soul today. I have a longing for unity, healing, and restoration. There's an old message about *re-digging the wells*:

When Isaac entered a land without water, he remembered that his father Abraham had once dug wells there. Over time, the enemy had filled those wells with earth, blocking access to the life-giving water below.

So Isaac dug again the wells of his father.

WELLS OF LIVING WATER

Abraham dug in search of water; Isaac dug with the confidence that water was already there. He knew what he was uncovering. That certainty is powerful. God's divine resources are just beneath the surface.

Scripture tells us, "The thing that hath been, it is that which shall be... there is no new thing under the sun" (Ecclesiastes 1:9).

In our day, we often talk about moving forward—and yes, God is always leading us onward. But why should we ignore the spiritual wells our forefathers already opened? Bro. H. Richard Hall, Bro. William Branham, Bro. A. J. Tomlinson, and many others tapped into something real, something powerful, something that shaped generations. Why search for a new move of God, when the old wells still hold living water?

Jesus has already provided everything we need. Our task is to dig.

Dig through old wounds. Dig past pride and spiritual superiority. Dig beyond judgment, division, and the debris of past conflicts. Dig until every barrier between us and the flow of God's Spirit is removed. The digging may be hard, but the water is worth it.

Just as God breathed life into Adam, this water brings vitality, strength, and spiritual awakening. The word "rescue" keeps coming to me—recovering something precious, something worth fighting for. Jesus is our source. Where else could we turn?

So I'm asking you: come help us remove the debris that has hindered fellowship. I'm extending a hand of reconciliation. I'm thinking of the next generation—our children—who deserve to drink from the same well that nourished us. They deserve to know the depth of God's Spirit, the power of the Holy Ghost, the living water that never runs dry.

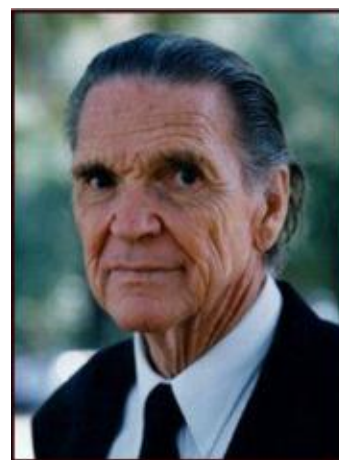

SAFE IN THE SHADOW OF THE ALMIGHTY

There is nothing as majestic as the flight of an eagle. When I see it, I'm reminded of the scripture that says, "they that wait upon the Lord shall mount up with wings as eagles!" (Isaiah 40:31).

There is one breed of eagle that will build a nest and raise its young. When it's time, the mother eagle will literally push her babies out of the nest. As the little eaglet falls down the face of the cliff, it is scared at what's happening—plunging down toward certain death if something doesn't happen. Then suddenly, **instinct** takes over. Something inside the DNA of that baby eaglet tells it to spread its wings. As those wings are stretched out, they catch the wind, the fall slows, and soon that baby eaglet is not falling anymore—it begins to **rise!** Soon it's flying!

But that her people also revere the female deity, the mother-goddess Athar, is troubling to him. He has noted how they had presented the Queen on her arrival. Was this mere political pomp? Or a belief that their Queen is connected to the goddess? He asks her about it.

"No, O King. I am no goddess, nor the daughter of a goddess. We Sabeans are not like the Egyptians. We do not venerate Rulers in such ways. I am only a mortal, not above any person, not even above a slave in the eyes of heaven. It is only my duty to rule as Queen because I inherited the position from my father."

"So, your ivory throne, the peacock curtain, the elephants and lions, these are not religious symbols?"

"No. Only to demonstrate the pride of Sheba and Ophir. Ivory for our purity. Leopard skin for our cunning.

Peacock feathers for the beauty of our land. Living lions for the boldness of our people. And the elephants for our enduring strength."

"And none of these are emblems of your gods Rammon and Athar?"

"No, O King. Rammon is not to be described by such things, except as he is the god of the land that has produced them. Rammon is the sun that rises over Ophir and our Yemen lands. He brings to us the blessings of many fruits in the warm months." "The sun rises everywhere at all times, Queen Bilquis, not only in your land, and not only in summer."

Ah, but the sun does not shine the same in all lands. See middle Arabia? It is terrible. Desert, dry, with little life. No one may exist there easily. The sun of Arabia does not bear the blessings of Rammon. Yet Rammon brings the blessings of the sun to the people of Sheba. See? The time of growth and harvest is the time of Rammon.

But Rammon is not here in your land, O King. Here is the Jehovah of Israel only. He it is Who brings the blessings of sun and rain to this place. Is it not so?"

"Not so with Jehovah, O Queen."

"No? How, then?"

"We speak of Jehovah as El-Elion, the Most High God. He is the Only God, supreme in all places, everywhere, and at all times. My father, King David, sang of Him as the God over all the earth, Who made the heavens, the seas, the earth, and all that is in them."

"But, O King, each nation, and each season, must have its own god. We must know this. Each country is distinct from another, as the



READ AND DECLARE LIFE TODAY!

As we pull back the veil of the mentioned blessing found in the first chapter of the book of Revelation, we find that John first mentions, “He that readeth,” and continues with, “and they that hear,” and the keeping of “those things which are written therein” (1:3). All of these come in the powerful words of John, inspired by the Holy Ghost.

John indicates, actually reading of scripture, hearing which undoubtedly refers to the necessity of physically being present for the preaching or teaching of the Word. Lastly, but certainly not least, the keeping of those things which one has read and heard. In fact, under the Old covenant God told Joshua to have the children of Israel to talk about the covenant, which they have heard, which here implies the word actually being read by someone aloud and when you walk in your daily routines, when you lie down and rise up. As well, God told them to write them on the doorposts of their houses.

As believers, our consistent commitment to reading the covenant promises, hearing them and applying them, we invite the powerful transformative power of His word to not only, break strongholds and undesirable behaviors that bind and hinder us, but at the same time it continues to transform us into the fruitful vessels He desires to bring glory to the Father. It also brings His presence and glory to the realization of those we interact with on a daily basis.

As a matter of fact, in the book of Joshua, chapter one, after the death of Moses, God tells Joshua in verse eight, to keep the laws of this book always on your lips and meditate on them day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful. Who doesn't want to be prosperous and successful? One of the words used here in the King James translated from the Hebrew in verse eight is, “meditate” in Hebrew it's “hagah” meaning to murmur or moan. Not as in grumbling or moaning as in complaining which oftentimes is far to easy to do. But rather as in, soft whispering tones of the words you're reading.

MUSIC IN GOD'S HOUSE? YES!

Music has always held a special place in the worship of God, not because humans invented it for religious use, but because Scripture declares it is a God-given means of honoring Him.

In the Old Testament, musical worship is woven into the life of Israel. David appointed Levites to sing and play instruments before the ark, what we now call “music ministry” in the house of God (1 Chron. 25). Temple worship under Solomon continued, with musicians serving by the

command of the Lord through His prophets (2 Chron. 29:25). The Psalms, Israel’s songbook, show music used for praise, sorrow, thanksgiving, repentance, and celebration, revealing its power to express every emotion—every experience—before God.

In New Testament believers are instructed to sing “psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs and making melody in your heart to the Lord”—expression of gratitude and encouragement for each other (Eph. 5:19;

Col. 3:16). How often have you found yourself humming a hymn? This morning, I awakened with “His Banner Over Me Is Love,” resounding in my mind!

Even in suffering, Paul and Silas worshipped in song (Acts 16:25). Heaven is a place filled with music, where the redeemed sing new songs before God’s throne (Rev. 5:9).

Biblically, music belongs in the house of God because it glorifies Him, unites His people, and echoes the worship of heaven.

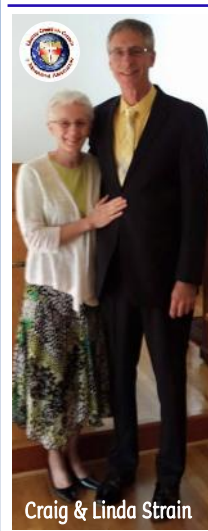
