



## SB 2 Education Savings Account Program

The Radford School Board has been monitoring the SB2 Education Savings Account Program (school vouchers).

SB2 passed both the Texas House and Senate. Both the House and Senate will now have to work out the differences in Senate Bill 2. The last step will be to have the Governor sign the legislation.

Radford School intends to apply pending final review of the bill to be an approved provider once the state eligibility guidelines and requirements become available and outline procedures for potentially new students and current students enrolled at Radford School, etc.

Potential program participants must still meet Radford School's admission process for matriculation. Approved students wanting to enroll in grades already capped will be placed on a waiting list. It should be noted that Radford has not and does not have the capacity to serve students with special needs at this time.

Students slots available in Grades: Early Childhood (3 yrs), Pre-K, K, 1<sup>st</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and 11<sup>th</sup>. Students seeking to enroll in 12<sup>th</sup> grade will be considered on an individual basis and must be able to meet Radford School graduation requirements within the specified year.

The Radford School Board will continue to monitor developments as SB2 guidelines are finalized.
