God Gave

Advent is here! This season our church is stepping into a story that doesn't start with our effort, our plans, or our perfectly coordinated holiday schedules — it starts with God giving. Before we could make sense of our messes, before we could even think about reaching for Him, God reached for us. Advent is our yearly reminder that the heart of Christmas is a God who gives generously, faithfully, and sometimes in ways that surprise us. Our sermon series, "God Gave," walks us through the gifts God poured out then and still pours out now.

We begin with the beautiful truth that God Gave a Promise. At the start of the Christmas story, God doesn't hand out instructions — He hands out assurance. The promise of Emmanuel, "God with us," came long before Mary even learned what was happening. God had already given grace, favor, and a miraculous plan. His promises might sometimes feel delayed or confusing (like tracking a package that apparently "left the facility" three days ago), but they are never uncertain. Advent invites us to rest in the God who keeps His word, even when we don't yet see how.

We then move to the reminder that God Gave a Purpose. Joseph's plans were thoroughly disrupted — nothing about his situation made sense on paper. But in the middle of his complicated circumstances, God gave clarity, courage, and direction. Joseph teaches us that God's purpose often arrives wrapped in the unexpected. And while we might prefer tidy answers and predictable paths, God gives us what we truly need to follow Him. Peace doesn't come from figuring everything out; it comes from trusting the One holding the map.

Next, we celebrate that God Gave a Partner. When Mary went running to Elizabeth, she wasn't just looking for moral support — she was stepping into one of the sweetest friendships in Scripture. God gave them each other as confirmation, encouragement, and joy (and honestly, who doesn't need at least one friend who makes your baby leap with happiness?). Advent reminds us that God often strengthens our faith through people who show up, cheer us on, and walk with us when the road gets bumpy.

Then comes the good news that God Gave Good News — and He gave it to shepherds. Not influencers. Not kings. Not the people who had their act together. Shepherds. Ordinary, overlooked workers minding their business on the night shift. Before they ran to the manger or spread the word, God gave them awe and joy. The Gospel always starts as a gift we receive with wonder before it becomes a message we pass along.

At the center of everything stands the miracle that God Gave Himself. In a quiet, crowded town, in a stable no one thought twice about, God came close. He wrapped Himself in humanity, breathed our air, and took on our fragility. He gave light to darkness, hope to the hopeless, and love with skin on. Christmas is not about what we offer God — it's about what God offers us: Himself. Advent invites us to welcome Christ again with openness, gratitude, and maybe a little awe that the King of the universe chose a manger and not a palace.

Finally, we remember that God Gave Peace. Simeon and Anna show us what it looks like to wait well — with patience, hope, and a kind of peace that doesn't depend on circumstances (or on how long the line is at the checkout). God gave them promises to cling to, purpose to live out, and peace to carry them all the way home. Their story reminds us that Christmas is not the grand finale of the season — it's the starting point of walking with Jesus into whatever comes next.

This Advent, may we open our hands and hearts to receive what God gives. The entire Christmas story — and every part of our own story — begins with a giving God. As we journey through these themes together, may we laugh, reflect, and rediscover the generosity of the God who gives... and keeps on giving.




